# Locals fare well in Soquel meet

SOQUEL — Harbor High School's Kelly Inicki captured fourth place in the girls' varsity race Saturday to lead local finishers in the 50-school, 850-runner Soquel Invitational cross country meet.

Aptos High took fourth in small-schools varsity team standings, Watsonville was second in the large-schools sophomore division and Soquel was fourth in the small-schools sophomores bracket.

Team champions were El Cerrito (varsity girls and large-school varsity boys), Concord (small-school varsity boys and JV boys), Madera (large-school sophomore boys and freshmen), Half Moon Bay (small-school sophomore boys), Roosevelt (small-school freshmen) and College Park (fresh-soph girls).

The meet was held for the 16th consecutive year at Soquel High, although Saturday's edition was over a revised 2.4-mile course. Runners came from throughout Northern and Central California.

Inicki was thwarted in a bid to repeat the win she scored as a freshman in 1983, clocking 15:23. Marin Catholic's Molly Burke, with whom Inicki has been having very competitive races all year, won in 14:46.

In the small-school boys' varsity event, Dan Boyle of Harbor was sixth in 13:29 to pace local finishers. Chris Connell of Aptos was ninth in 13:34.

Santa Cruz High elected to compete in the large-school boys' varsity division and the Cardinals' Brandon Smith clocked 12:49 for sixth place and teammate Bill Bennett was 30th in 13:31. Santa Cruz finished fourth.

Lionel Barragan and Brian Watkins of Watsonville were third and 12th, respectively, in the large-school sophomore race.

Soquel's Britana Keen was third at 16:41 in the fresh-soph girls' event.

Heath Pillig of San Lorenzo Valley took eighth at 16:33 in the
