

Callon's victory leads Bells to WCAL title

Bellarmino Prep's Mark Callon won his second consecutive West Catholic Athletic League cross-country title to lead the Bells to their sixth consecutive WCAL championship at Crystal Springs Wednesday.

Bellarmino, as usual, used its depth to dominate. The Bells (16 points) easily outdistanced Serra (60), St. Ignatius (68) and St. Francis (107).

final in 17 years, veteran Bellarmino coach Terry Ward said. Callon won in 15:19, 24 seconds ahead of teammate Torre Pena.

Bellarmino took five of the top six places. Ian Champeny, Dan Fisher and Rob Meinhardt of Bellarmino placed third, fourth and sixth, respectively. St. Ignatius'

Rob Lindstrom finished fifth.

Parker Kelly led Serra with an eighth-place finish.

Bellarmino, Serra, S.I. and St. Francis advanced to the Central Coast Section Region I meet Nov. 19 at Crystal Springs. Bellarmino has won the past five Region I meets.

In a nonleague meet, Gunn's boys and girls swept visiting Lynbrook. Anand Gokel and Jenny Pickering won the boys' and girls' races, respectively.
