

Carlmont and Bupp champions

Scots' depth produces PAL cross country title

Woodside High's Andy Bupp won his ninth race in as many tries against Central Coast Section competition, but it was Carlmont that ran away with the team title in the Peninsula Athletic League cross country finals Wednesday at the Crystal Springs course.

Bupp, the top-ranked runner in the Times Tribune's Peninsula rankings, covered the 2.9-mile course in 15:09 to outdistance teammate John Hannon by 22 seconds. Hannon is ranked No. 6.

Woodside, however, finished fifth in the team standings — far behind Carlmont's winning team score of 58 points. The Scots, ranked No. 5 as a team, were paced by Dave Olden's seventh-place finish in 16:20. Teammates Mark Tanner and Stuart Lawrence

were not far behind, finishing eighth and ninth, respectively.

San Mateo, led by No. 2-ranked Derek Waxman's third-place finish, was second with 70 points. Burlingame (73) was third and Aragon (96) was fourth.

In the girls race, Alva Dancel of Mills won in 19:03, leading her team to the title with 40. Burlingame (72) was second, Carlmont (80) was third and Aragon (90) was fourth. Dancel is the No. 3-ranked runner on the Peninsula.

Carlmont's effort was paced by Julie Meade, Suzanne Jones and Cindy Mahaffey, all of whom finished in the top 10.

Meade finished third in 19:45, eight seconds behind Jane Vega of Burlingame. Jones (20:11) was fifth and Mahaffey (20:37) was seventh.

Jones was the defending PAL champion.
