



### 1989 CIF/Reebok State Cross Country Preview

(In the article below, the following Section abbreviations are used—San Diego (SDS), Southern (SS), Central (CS), Central Coast (CCS), Los Angeles (LAS), North Coast (NCS), Sac Joaquin (SJS), Northern (NS)

As we close out the decade of the 1980's with the Third California Reebok State High School Cross Country Championships we are at an interesting point in our sport. In the third year of these championships we have evolved into an interesting competitive parity between the different areas of the state that should add a special excitement to the races here. One great outgrowth of this State level competition has been a change in focus for many schools from what it takes to be successful locally to what it will take to bring a championship home at this level. We have squads and individuals from all areas of the state in contention for the awards that will be passed out before the

Our first competition this morning will sort out bragging rights amont the State's Division I Boys teams. A group from Camarillo High (SS), led by Abe Valdez, has dominated all of its competitions during statewide travels this Fall, with a team time comparison this morning with 1987 champion and #1 ranked nationally Arroyo (El Monte-SS) (who races 78:23 here) lending strength to the Ventura County power's bid for a mythical national championship. Two time defending individual champion Bryan Dameworth (Agoura-SS), who has been destroying decade old course records along the way this season, will lead a fine Charger team here. Coach Joe Stocking has Jeremy Seven leading a very successful De La Salle (Concord-NCS) team that should break up the historical Southern Section team domination near the top end of this division. Saddleback (Santa Ana-SS), San Clemente (SS), Madera (CS), and Poway (SD), the latter two ferocious pack running groups, are other very solid squads. Chasing two-time defending champ Dameworth individually should be Louis Quintana (Arroyo Grande-SS), who set an 11th grade course record earlier this fall at the heavily used Mt. SAC facility, with Dave Hartman (Canyon, Canyon Country-SS), Eliazar Herrera (Hoover, Glendale-SS), David Virgil Santant, Santee-SD), Obed Aguirre (San Fernando-LAS), Matt Ringer (Homestead, Sunnyvale-CCS), and Damon Chamberlain (Casa Roble, Orangevale-SJS) impressive in Section Championship

Our Girls Division I title race will feature the top ranked squad all season, Agoura (SS), trying to hold off the late season charge of two time defending champion Palos Verdes (SS). Agoura leads with 1987 Division I Champion Deena Drossin (she was 3rd in 88), who had a strong Section Finals effort, and the Chargers hope to complete an undefeated season here. Palos Verdes has a pack that will gap at about a minute in their determined chase. Mt. Carmel (San Diego) has raced strongly against PV this fall, with the gently rolling Woodward Park course suiting the San Diego champion squad nicely. Buena (Ventura-SS) has put together a solid season and will be ready should any of the top squads falter. San Pasqual (Escondido-SDS), Arroyo Grande (SS), Alta Loma (SS), Overfelt (San Jose-CCS), Clovis West (Fresno-CS), and Bella Vista (Fair Oaks-SJS) should battle for positions in the top half dozen. Individually, the Girls Division I race should be a classic. 1987 Champion Deena Drossin (Agoura-SS) will have her hands full. Becky Spies (Livermore-NCS) has already raced 10:35 on the track for 2 miles this Fall with the nation's #4 returning 800 meter runner (2:10.45) and miler (4:54.7) spending the Fall rearranging course records. Shelley Taylor (Edison, Huntington Beach-SS) is undefeated in the South, with Jeannie Rothman (Westlake, Westlake Village-SS-2nd) the only one closer than 100 yards to Taylor at the finish this season in their Section Finals run. Beth Bartholomew (Fremont, Sunnyvale-CCS), the nation's #3 returning miler (4:53.30c) is impressive this Fall, with Krissy Look (Shasta, Redding-NS) dominating her part of the State. Tanya Brix (University, Irvine-SS) is another coming on strong late in the season, with Martha Pinto (Katella, Anaheim) running some fine races on courses similar to Woodward Park

The Boys Division II title run was made more interesting when season long #1 ranked Corona del Mar (SS) fell victim to the peculiar Southern Section Championship format which had them competing against larger schools during the qualifying process and CdM was not able to move on to this Meet. Jesuit (Carmichael-SJS), 2nd last year to Cdm, is the favorite this weekend, coming off a good Section

Finals effort. Lompoc (SS), St. Anthony (Long Beach-SS), South Pasadena (SS), 4th in 88, and Palos Verdes (SS) will put up a spirited chase, with the Central Section's Wasco and Lemoore very competitive during a season of statewide travels. Palo Alto (CCS) has dominated its area at this level, with El Camino (Oceanside-SD) slipping past a good La Jolla (SD) group in their Section's championship run. Yreka (NS) and Arcata (NCS) were also impressive in Section Final efforts. Individually this will be a very interesting division. Paul Goodrich and Andrew Wignot (Dos Pueblos, Goleta-SS), Kevin Berkowitz (Hayward-NCS), Paul Eley (Mills, Millbrae-CCS), Andy Bupp (Woodside-CCS), Derek Waxman (San Mateo-CCS), Eric Taylor (Grant, Sacramento-SJS), Jose Trujillo (Golden West, Visalia-CS), and Jeremy Redding (Central Valley-NS) all appear close on paper.

The Girls Division II championship contest is another with a wide geographic spread. Highly ranked two-time defending champion Newport Harbor (SS) fell victim to Section division peculiarities during the qualifying process and will not be in attendance. La Jolla (SD) has put together a fine season, with a return to form of Malee Ferguson and continued good running of Patty Villarreal making them the favorites. Mills (Millbrae-CCS) is a fine team, with Jill Kurz and Alva Dancel leading. Corona del Mar (SS), Nordhoff (Ojai-SS), and San Marino (SS) will lead that Section's charge, with St. Francis (Sacramento-SJS), led by Sybelle McFadden, dominating in its area. Defending Champion Karen Hecox (South Hills, West Covina-SS) returns to defend her title, with runner-up Tina Gorbet (Lassen, Susanville-NS) back to challenge. Sarah Riley (Campolindo, Moraga-NCS) has looked strong in the Bay area.

The Division III races are what the State Meet is really about in many ways. During the season these teams from schools of under 700 students are often buried when forced to compete against schools a couple of times their size. When placed against teams at their own level the competition is fierce and the quality of performances high. 1989 will be no exception. On the Boys side Laguna Beach (SS) has come on very strong lately to throw out a big challenge to divisional favorite McFarland (CS). The two teams are very close on paper, with fine individuals David Crain leading for LB and Johnny Samaniego for the Central Section power. Yosemite (Oakhurst-CS) was only two points behind McFarland in the Section Finals run. Bret Harte (Altaville-SJS), led by Brian Singleton, York (Monterey-CCS), with Jeff Arnold on top, Stevenson (Pebble Beach-CCS), Lick-Wilmerding (San Francisco-NCS), University (San Francisco-NCS), Calvin Christian (Escondido-SDS), and the Southern Section contingent of La Salle (Pasadena), defending champion Sherman Indian (Riverside), and last year's runner up group, Marantha (Sierra Madre), always strong. Defending champion Matt Metzger (University, SF-NCS) is running to good times lately, with Oscar Perez (Pater Noster, LA-SS), last year's second finisher, his area's small school titlest a week ago. Last year's 3 through 5 finishers, Oscar Montes (Maranatha, Sierra Madre-SS), Melvin Kenton (Sherman Indian, Riverside-SS), and Bob Bush (Inland Christian, San Bernardino-SS) all return, with Bill Crabbe (College Prep, Oakland-NCS), Ken Rose (Colfax-SJS), and David Soto (Christian, El Cajon-SDS) looking good in recent efforts.

The Girls Division III run will finish our day off with what should be a tight team struggle. Defending champion Bret Harte (Altaville) came south to the Mt. SAC Invitational and narrowly edged the best from that part of the state. The Bullfrogs go into this competition without the margin of dominance they came in with last year. McFarland (CS) was next at Mt. SAC, with Southern Section squads Marantha, and L.A. Baptist (Sepulveda) leading the chase from their section. Lick-Wilmerding (San Francisco-NCS) handled last year's fourth placers here, University (San Francisco-NCS) in their Section run, with Garces (Bakersfield-CS), Marymount (LA-SS), and Paraclete (Lancaster-SS) other solid groups. Individually, Jean Harvey (Paraclete, Lancaster-SS) is the highest returnee at 3rd place, with Laura Hamady (Urban, San Francisco-NCS), Trixie Robbins (Orlando), Amy Davidson (Bret Harte-SJS), Viviana Reza (Coronado-SDS), and Cedar Lindsley (Cate, Carpinteria-SS) individual threats.

### Mehas to Serve as Honorary Starter



A native of Fresno, the 50-year-old Mehas received his bachelor's degree in political science

and physical education from Fresno State University in 1963, his master's degree from UCLA in 1967, and his doctorate in education from the University of Southern California in 1979.
