- 2. Sub-Section Meet: The top seven (7) teams, and the top four (4) individual finishers from each heat, plus the next four (4) fastest individuals qualify for the Section Meet.

SEEDING Please refer to Section 7 in the Cross Country section of the 1990-91 CCS Tournament Guide.

COACHES

There will be a brief coaches' meeting at 10AM on Saturday and 1PM on Wednesdays to cover any last minute details. Approximately ten minutes before the start of each Boys' race of Division II, and IV, respectively, there will be a brief meeting for any late-arriving coaches.

CHECK-IN Make certain that prior to the Coaches Meeting you have checked in at the scorer's table to pick up your Meet packet. This packet will include assigned numbers (to be worn on the chest), pins, starting positions sheet, and scoring envelopes.

RULES The 1990 National Federation Track and Cross Country Rules will govern all Sub-Section, Section and State meets. Particular attention needs to be given to the following:

- 1) Spikes -- Spikes are not allowed.
- 2) Rule 9-5.1 thru 9-5.4 -- Runners must be dressed in identical proper team uniforms -jerseys and shorts. The 1990 Nat. Federation Rule Book will be enforced. All teams must be in starting positions 5 minutes before the start of the race; meet referee and starter will check all team uniforms.

COURSE CONDUCT The following are important guidelines of which coaches, athletes and spectators are reminded--ignoring any of the following could jeopardize our opportunity to use this fine facility in the future:

- 1) Park automobiles, busses, vans, etc. in authorized areas only. <u>DO NOT BLOCK DRIVEWAYS!!!</u> <u>BUSSES</u>
 <u>MUST PARK ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF HALLMARK DR. DOWN THE STREET, BEYOND ALL HOUSES.</u>
- 2) Remember this is a residential area -- coaches, athletes, and spectators should stay away from the private homes, their lawns, fences, driveways, etc.
- 3) Please stay out of the fenced-off area near the water tank.
- 4) There is a public pay phone located near the tennis courts.
- 5) There is an EXTREME fire hazard in this area; therefore, NO SMOKING will be allowed in the area.
- 6) NO PETS (leashed or unleashed) ARE ALLOWED.
- 7) Clean up the area you and your team have occupied before you leave the area. Thanks for your cooperation.
- 8) USE ONLY THE WALKWAY NEAR THE TENNIS COURTS FOR ENTRANCE INTO THE COURSE!!!
- 9) No radios, frisbees, or footballs should be taken onto the course, and please refrain from throwing rocks.
- 10) Coaches & athletes are reminded to stay out of the scoring shed and the immediate area surrounding it.
- 11) All spectators and coaches must stay behind the ropes and/or chalk markings when the runners cross the top of the hill. Do not assist your runners on the course by running with them, etc., particularly in the general area of cardiac/agony hill. This is considered unsportsmanlike, and you put yourself and everyone connected with the meet in an embarrassing position.

 BASICALLY, COACHES SHOULD STAY OFF THE RUNNING COURSE.

<u>PRE-MEET</u> Jogging the course before the meet is permitted. The course must be cleared prior to the starting of the first race.

SCORING The double tag and chest number system will be used to provide immediate results, identify qualifying teams and individuals to the State CIF meet, and to provide a back-up system.

There will be pre-assigned chest numbers and safety pins in each school's meet packet which you will pick up prior to the meet. These numbers are to be worn on the front of the jersey. They will have a tear-off bottom portion with a pre-printed name tag. This tear-off portion will be collected at the finish line. DO NOT REMOVE THE NAME TAG FROM THIS PORTION AND DO NOT SWITCH NUMBERS. (FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE DIRECTIONS COULD COST YOU A QUALIFYING POSITION.)

Please check the spelling of your name, year in school, and school you represent for possible errors.

Fill out the finish tag the athlete receives as he/she proceeds through the chute. Fill out the tag completely: i.e., first and last name, school name, and year in school. Place the tag in the scoring envelope, add up your score, record the total points in appropriate space, and return the entire envelope to the scorer's table.

IF YOUR TEAM BECOMES INCOMPLETE DURING THE RACE, PLEASE BE SURE TO INDICATE THIS ON THE ENVELOPE FIRST, THEN REPORT IT IMMEDIATELY TO THE MEET DIRECTOR!!!

Coaches are reminded to stay away from the chute area as their athletes are finishing --WE NEED YOUR COOPERATION!

In case of tied teams, the tie shall be broken by comparing the 6th place finishers of the tied teams.

Official results of the Section Meet will be completed and mailed to the participating schools following the meet.

AWARDS See Tournament Guide Section 9.

Certificates shall be awarded to the individuals of both the 1st and 2nd place teams in all Divisions and for both Girls and Boys teams.

ELIGIBLE See Tournament Guide Section 10!!!!

ATHLETES NO INCLIGIBLE ATHLETE (FOR WHATEVER REASON) SHALL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.

STARTING Starting positions for the individuals and teams will be determined by random drawing. Sub-Section POSITION placement will be taken into consideration in the case of the individual qualifiers.

A double starting line, with a 5 yard separation will be used. Three runners from each team will line up on the front line of the starting box, and the remaining team members will line up on the second line. If a qualifying team is not complete on the day of the meet the coach <u>MUSI</u> notify the meet director during the coaches meeting. If a complete team starts the race but less than five (5) finish, <u>PLEASE</u> ...

INFORM THE MEET DIRECTOR IMMEDIATELY!
