Paly boys, Gunn girls win titles

Gunn's Soderman runs life best to win girls race

Palo Alto High's boys cross-country team is right where it wants to be with the Central Coast Section finals on the near horizon.

Palo Alto's top five runners finished in consecutive order — second place through sixth — at the Santa Clara Valley Athletic League finals at Crystal Springs on Tuesday.

The Vikings combined for a team score of 26. Milipitas was a distant second with 62.

In the girls race, Gunn's Teenya Soderman clipped 15 seconds off her

previous best at Crystal Springs, leading the Titans to first place.

Gunn's girls finished with 33 points, ahead of second-place Palo Alto (45) and Mountain View (66).

"It was a good performance," Palo Alto coach George Erving said of his boys team. "We're clocking in about right where we should be. And we should improve from here."

St. Ignace will be Palo Alto's main competition at the CCS Division III meet. The Wildcats' top runners, Mark McManus and Brad Glomser, usually set a blistering pace.

"I don't we'll be able to go out with them," Erving said. "But we'll want to stay in contact and not lose sight of them."

Gabe Kugler led the Palo Alto pack with a second-place finish in a life-best 16:11 on the 2.8-mile course.

Erik McMichael was third in a post-race 16:13. Jon Hammar (fourth, 16:31), Ralf Kugler (fifth, 16:45) and Fred Dolan (sixth, 16:47) comprised the rest of the Palo Alto scorers. Brian Wolman (eighth, 16:52) and Tim Ross (12th, 17:10) were non-scorers that other schools would love to have.

"We're all satisfied because of the point we're at now," Gabe Kugler said. "We're all tired because of all the training we've been doing, but we'll be ready for CCS and the state meet. I'm really psyched for CCS."

Kugler and McMichael ran first and second for most of the race before Milipitas sophomore Eduardo Avila streaked by in the final yards to take

individual honors in 16:04.

"Villa ran a great race," Kugler said. "But I'll be more concerned with the Ignatius guys at CCS."

In the girls race, Soderman clocked 18:45, winning by a big margin over Los Altos' Tracy Shoemaker.

"At the end I thought I heard some footsteps," Soderman said. "That gave me some impetus."

The next objective for Gunn is to place in the top two at the CCS meet and qualify for state.

The rest of Gunn's scoring placers were Heather Douglas (fourth), Amanda Deep Dillon (seventh), Amy Moberg (eighth) and Mika Fiat (16th). Mountain View's Carolyn Yang placed third and Santa Clara's Sandy

Dryck was fifth.

The Area Athletic League

Las Gatas swept the boys and girls team championships, but Bonnetate's Eddie Mazyak and Fremont's Julia Huff were the individual winners.

St. Francis took second in the girls competition with 44 points to Los Gatos' 37. Fremont was third with 68.

The Las Gatos boys scored 28, followed by Fremont with 63.

Mazyak, picking up where graduated teammate Matt Ringer left off, won by a 26-second margin over Fremont's Hal Tran in 16:11.

Huff made it six consecutive girls individual championships for Fremont, winning in 18:44.
