Dragons sweep the field

■ Bishop O'Dowd runners finish 1-2-3 to capture girls 3-A title

OAKLAND — It was easy as 1-2-3 for Bishop O'Dowd High's girls team at the North Coast Section/Reebok Cross Country Meet of Champions Saturday at Mills College.

Competing in Division III, the Dragons' Miesha Marzell, Anjelica Randall and Nicky Saleta topped a team title by sweeping the first three positions of the three-mile race.

Marzell's time, 19:16, was the fastest girls effort of the day by 30 seconds and 53 seconds better than Randall's mark.

"I like this course, it was a nice course once you got past that hill," said Marzell, the 1992 state champion in the 800 meters.

O'Dowd, which will be among the favorites at the state championships at Woodward Park in Fresno Saturday, beat runner-up Carondelet by 43 points, finishing with 36.

Alameda senior Chris Palmer topped the Division III boys field, winning by 13 seconds over runner-up Aaron Daniel of Livermore in a time of 16:46 for three miles on the picturesque course.

San Leandro sophomore Keith Kennedy finished in second place in Division II boys, in 16:52 — 20 seconds behind winner Matt Creason from Eureka. Castro Valley's John Atwood will also compete in Fresno because he finished fourth in Division II, in 17:00.

James Logan's girls team won the Division I team title, led by stars Kim Wilkes, Mei-Ling McNamara and Michelle Kiyono, who finished second, third and fourth.

Also, three Logan boys — Sam Yemane, Alejandro Pena and John Lockard — qualified as individuals in Division I boys:
