As per our agreement at the 2003 post-season meeting, the El Camino league will run first in 2015 and the DeAnza league will run first in 2015.

Last year, all non-scoring junior/senior boys ran in a 2nd heat of the boys varsity race, starting 1:00 after the first heat. As per our pre-season minutes, we intended that the non-scoring senior girls do as the boys did but I think that due to the small number of girls in the field that at least the El Camino non-scorers starting in the first heat but on the 3rd line.

There are no limits on the number of runners who may run in the JVG and FSB races. Our bylaws allow each league to run all of its FSB and JVG together or to run a 2nd heat for these races. For 2014 the DeAnza league decided to run all of its FSB and JVG in one race (111 in the FSB race and 94 in the JVG race). The El Camino decided to run two races for the FSB (81 and 73) and one JVG race (97) The 2nd FSB race for the El Camino league started 2 minutes after the 1st heat.

- 10. Rules for using Crystal Springs:
 - a. At no time is there to be anyone up on water tank hill.
 - b. Buses are to drop off athletes after the the last house on the right side of Hallmark Avenue. After dropping off the athletes, the buses are not to turn around using the driveways. They should use the streets. Also, the buses should not double park while dropping off the runners. If they do so and a police officer observes them, they will be given a ticket. Further, the school will be subject to banishment from the course in the future.
 - c. There is to be no throwing of objects, including rocks, frisbees and footballs. No music boxes that others may hear are allowed. Personal CD players/ radios are okay.
 - d. There is to be no hanging out in residential yards. These yards are private property. Athletes may not go onto Hallmark Dr after the meet unless accompanied by their coach and, then, only if their bus is ready to pick them up.
 - e. There is no smoking or pets in the park. Please remind the parents.
 - f. Each team is responsible for clearing their own trash before leaving their area.
 - g. No plastic or cardboard will be allowed to be dumped in the dumpster box or green garbage bins. Each team is responsible for removing all plastic bottles and carboard boxes from the course.
 - h. Tickets with a minimum fine of \$25.00 will be issued.
