The Spartan Harriers trampled once-proud Tennyson and previously undefeated San Lorenzo in the greatest barrage of personal best times ever witnessed. No less than 20 of our runners recorded personal bests and no less than 10 placed themselves on our all-time list in either the 2 or 3 mile course.

Not only were the personal best beaten, but they were smashed, annihilated, obliterated. The real amazing fact of the victory was not the scores but it was the times which were all recorded with two watches so they were accurate. The times were all so fast that I keep thinking we left out part of the course. But like Steve Derr said after finishing his 3 miles, "That sure was a fast race."

Mike Rudy started the whole thing by devistating his own course record by 29 seconds while running an smazing 11:09 although he was pushed the entire way by Durazo of Tennyson. Ken Miller still recovering from a cold still ran a strong race and finished just ahead of fast-improving Mitch Wright and Blake Cooper. All three recorded times on the all-time list.

Freshman standout Gene Rodgers in only his second race ran 10 seconds faster than Mike Rudy's best time last year. Sophomores Ecb Kuchenmaister and Chuck Stanton continued to show tremendous improvement as did Dave McKaig, Rick Ripoll, Mike Busha, Steve Shapiro, Kevin Hooper, Dick Meadows, and Guy Cambra. Mark Prichard ran well for his first race of the year as did Brad Silva, Brad Jones.

Tom Delfino and Randy DeValle both placed on the All-time 2-mile list as they finished together. This was Randy's best showing so far this year. Jim Phillips also ran his best race of the year and looked real strong as did Dwight Hooper, Brad Sundeen. Cary Dutra is still improving after recovering from an illness. Rich Anderson surprised after only a few workouts each week. Chuck Rego is still rounding into shape and Steve Garcia had his first taste of cross country racing.

Scott Wood was just tremendous. It seems impossible that anyone would break Danny Anderson's record but break it he did and by 22 seconds while improving his personal best time by 46 seconds. That is a remarkable accomplishment considering that Scott is in good shape and has been all year. Would anyone believe that Barr Parr would ever run as fast as Danny Anderson? Not me. However, Barry came within 1 second of Danny's all-time best. That time also beats those turned in by such names as Ed Riggs and Dave Champess.

Steve Derr continues to improve steadily by bettering his time by 37 seconds and taking 6th on the all-time list. Cary Turpen ran by far his best race of the year beating his best by 1 full minute. He is just getting into shape. Tim Rose in his first attempt at our 3 mile course ran the 10th best time ever recorded and Marvin Soc Hoo was right behind him closely followed by Rick Reed. Rick was counting places the whole race and after the first mile he informed me that he was ahead of Tennyson's 5th man.

Mike Brown and Mike Lemaster both ran extremely well for their first attempt at our 3 mile course and they both finished ahead of Tennyson's 4th man.

Great effort by everyone. Let's keep up the good work. Nock out, Sunnet.
