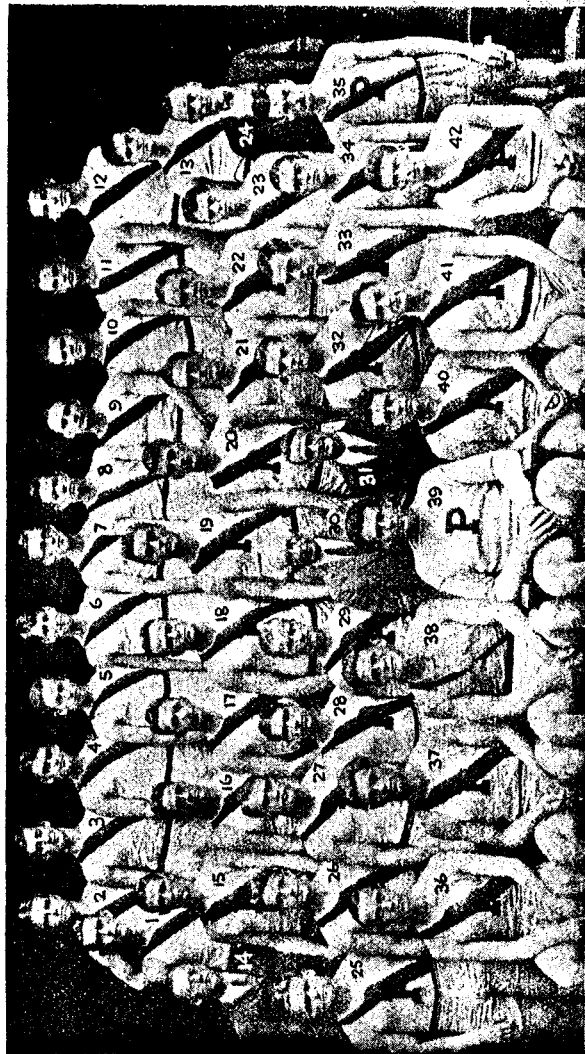

PRINCETON UNIVERSITY TRACK TEAM.

The Executive Committee has considered and recommends to the Association a balanced budget for the year 1925-1926 calling for expenditures of \$16,000 and estimated receipts of the same amount, and reports that the budget of 1924-1925 showed a net balance of \$1,077.04. This balance was due to the fact that the Souvenir Volume, owing to the delay in publication, was not published this year.

Track and Field Championship Meet.

Mr. Albert C. Bickford, Manager of the 1924 Track and Field Championship Meet, reported gross receipts of \$14,728.59, total expenses of \$6,159.75 and a net balance of \$8,568.84, together with interest on deposits of \$43.25.

Indoor Championship Meet.

Mr. Charles W. Crawford, Manager of the Indoor Meet, reported gross receipts of \$6,973.05, total expenses of \$4,008.67, and a net balance of \$2,964.38.

Cross-Country Runs.

Mr. Franklin E. Vilas, Manager of the Cross-Country Runs, reported total expenses of \$321.08, receipts from the program \$13, and the net expenses \$308.08.

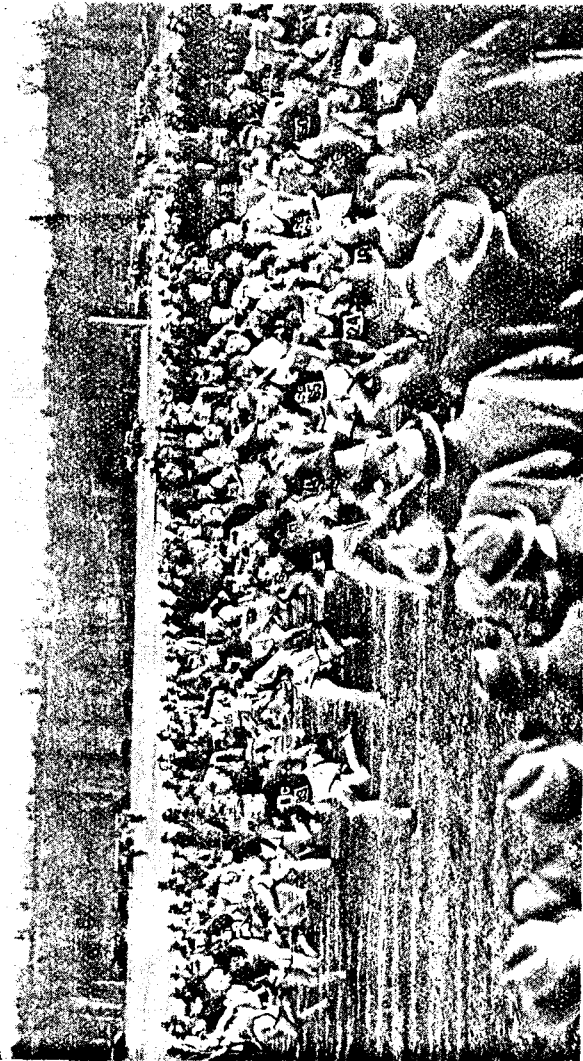

SEVENTEENTH ANNUAL 'VARSITY AND SIXTH ANNUAL FRESHMAN CROSS-COUNTRY RUNS.

The Seventeenth Annual 'Varsity and Sixth Annual Freshman Cross-Country Runs of the Association were held over the I.C.A.A.A. Cross-Country Course at Van Cortlandt Park, New York City, on Monday afternoon, November 23, 1925.

The meet was one of the most successful ever held. In spite of the chill wind, the weather was clear and the course in splendid shape. The attendance surpassed that of any previous meet and was estimated at about 3,000.

The 'Varsity run resulted in a victory for Syracuse University, whose exceptionally well-balanced team scored a total of 47 points, or 10 lower than the winner of the previous year. Pittsburgh, the champion team of 1924, was second with 84, and Harvard was third with 122. The finish of this race was considered by those who have watched cross-country championships for many years to be the closest and most thrilling in the history of the Association. At the three-mile mark Arthur Hillman of Maine was in the lead, with Willard L. Tibbetts of Harvard and James C. Loucks of Syracuse following closely. This order continued to the top of the ridge on the last lap, when Tibbetts assumed

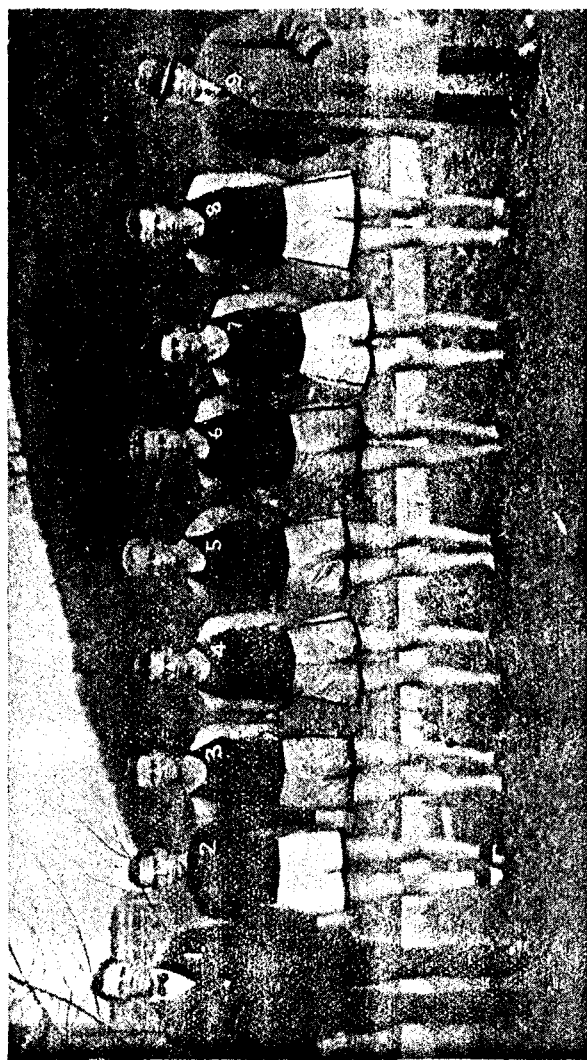


START OF THE I.C.A.A.A. VARSITY CROSS-COUNTRY RACE, 1927.

the lead. For nearly half a mile across the field to the finish, Tibbetts and Loucks were practically abreast, and for the last quarter of a mile they fought out the finish, a thing which is rarely seen in cross-country races. Tibbetts won by a yard in 30 minutes 34 seconds, more than 50 seconds better than the time for 1924, and 1 minute 36 seconds better than the 1923 time over the same course. While the Association does not recognize cross-country records for the obvious reason that no two cross-country courses are alike, this time is the best intercollegiate time made over the standard I.C.A.A.A. course adopted in 1923. The result in order of finish was as follows:

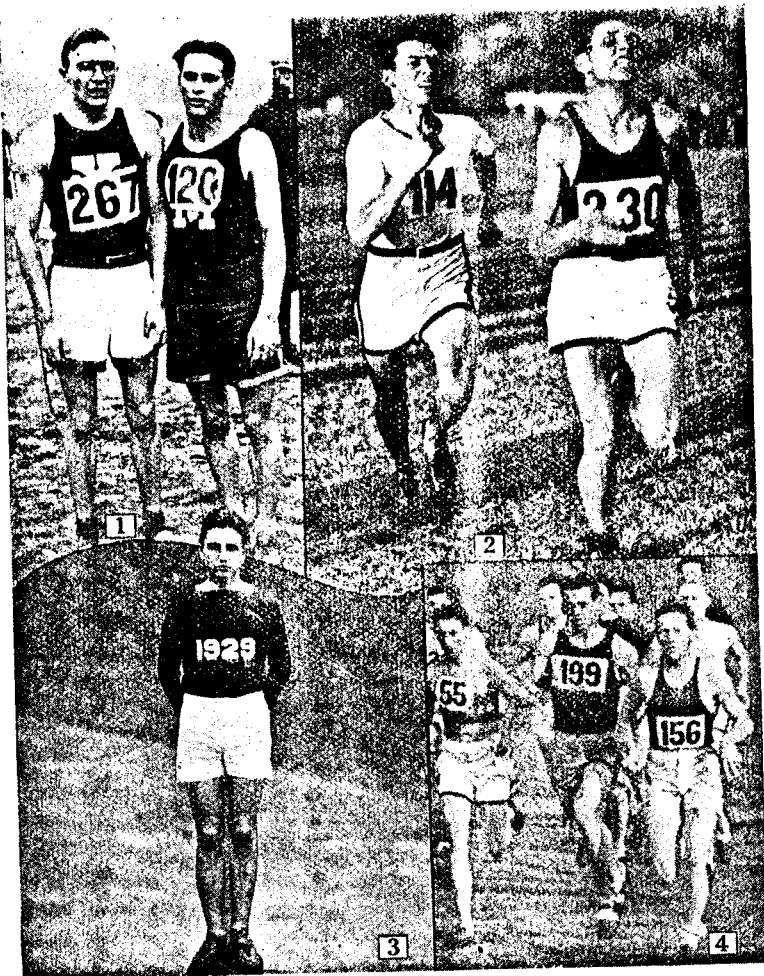
Union and Lafayette were not represented by full teams and therefore did not count in the scoring.

SIXTEENTH ANNUAL 'VARSITY AND FIFTH ANNUAL FRESHMAN CROSS-COUNTRY RUNS.

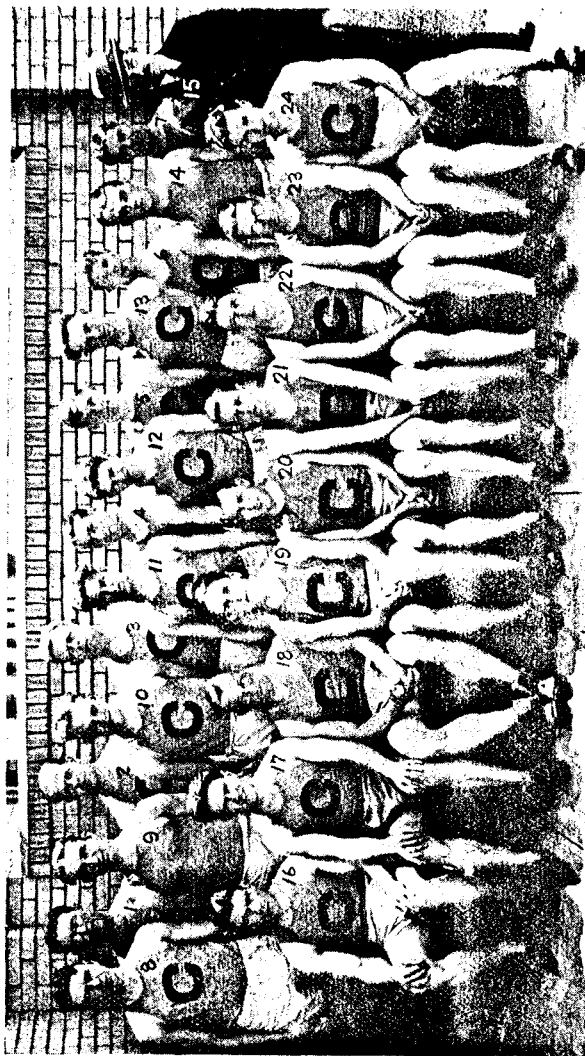
