Southern Californians can see the greatest track meet in American history with a minimum of trouble. One order takes care of air and ground transportation directly to the stadium, excellent tickets, and hotel accommodations.

The Olympic Trials at Stanford University are contested July 1 and 2 with final events each day. Hammer throw starts 2:30 p.m. Friday, other events at 5:30. Saturday events start at 1 p.m.

Your round trip flight via PSA's great turbo-jet will leave from L.A. International or Burbank (or San Diego) in time to make the hammer throw, returning Saturday after the meet.

Ground transportation will take you from the S.F. airport to the stadium and to your hotel after the meet, putting you in S.F. in time for dinner and doing the town. On Saturday you will be taken from the hotel to the stadium and back to the airport.

Tickets are for reserved seats for both days. Excellent seats will be with the "Track & Field News" group on the shady side of the stadium and will be better than can be obtained individually. Hotel accommodations are on the basis of two to a room with private bath, in the Union Square area. Add \$3 for a single room.

As only a limited number can be handled at this special price an early reservation is advisable.
