
# All Time Freshman List



#### ALL TIME FRESHMAN LIST

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#### FOREWARD

An overlooked facet of track statistics for many years was the keeping of lists for freshmen (first year) students at four year colleges and junior colleges. Since its founding in 1948, Track & Field News has run yearly freshman-junior college lists but for the first time an all-time list for freshmen is now presented.

Listed are the 25 best performers in the standard events plus comparable performances at the metric distances. As is usually the case when a newly compiled list is published there are omissions and probably some errors. Any omissions or errors that readers come across should be sent to Track & Field News.

One of the big problems in compiling such a list is to determine which athletes are freshmen, especially at the junior college level and at four-year schools where freshmen competed for the varsity. This was especially true during the war years when freshmen competed for the varsity at all schools. Another problem was securing accurate track information prior to World War II when the keeping of track statistics was not the fine art as it is today. Much thanks goes to H.D. Thoreau of San Francisco, whose scrapbooks of track statistics were of great value, not only during the pre-World War II period but in the post-war period as well.

Why should an all-time freshmen list be published? The answer is because freshmen at four-year colleges usually compete on their own level, such as the freshmen-junior college divisions that will be found at many meets. Most four-year schools also field separate frosh teams, except in the Big Ten and Big Eight Conferences where freshmen do not compete on the intercollegiate level at all and at schools that still use freshmen on the varsity. The number of schools allowing frosh to compete on the varsity gets smaller each year and there probably will come a time when no freshmen are allowed to compete on the varsity.

Why were junior college performers added? It was felt that first year students at junior colleges are equivalent to freshmen at four-year schools and thus could not be omitted. With the growing junior college movement around the United States it is hoped that we can publish an all-time junior college list sometime in the near future.

For the most part freshmen at four-year colleges and junior colleges are 19 or 20 years old but there are instances on the all-time list of athletes being as young as 17 and as old as 40. An interesting comparison can be made by examining the all-time high school list and then the all-time frosh list. Notice the great improvement in most events from an athlete's senior year in high school to his first year in college. Of course, most of the great improvement in the middle and long distance runs was mainly due to the large number of older foreign athletes who have been attending U.S. colleges in recent years.

ON THE COVER: Robert Hayes, Florida A&M, is the most outstanding freshman sprinter of all time, setting national freshmen records in 1961 of 9.3 in the 100 yard dash and 20.1 in the 220 on a straight-away. His 9.3 tied the world record at the time. He was only 18 years old during his freshmen year.
