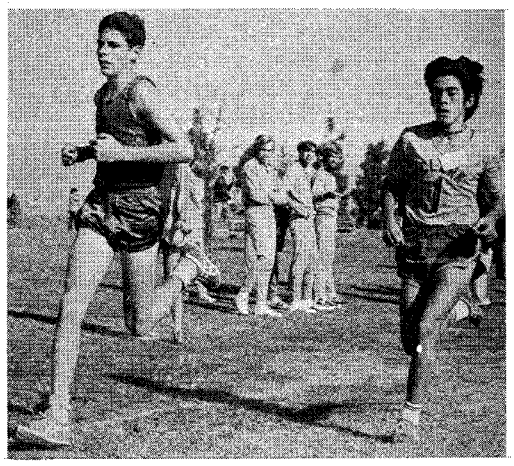

## MEET VALLEY ATHLETE

**LARRY BOAEN:** Senior, West High School, Bakersfield. Born September 1, 1953, at San Bernardino, Cal. 5'11", 145 pounds.  
**BEST TIMES:** 100--10.1, 220--21.1, 440--48.1, 880--1:57, mile relay leg--47.7.  
**TRAINING:** Once a day, 6 days a week, 12 months a year. Coached by Jim Wren.  
**HONORS-AWARDS:** 2 Valley Championship Mile Relay teams(best time in Valley history-3:14.8), 3 times League Champ 440, 2 times League cross country champ, Valley Cross Country Champ, Competed in State Meet 3 years. Fresno State Invitational Champ. Undefeated Senior year cross country.

Larry has just completed the "Grand Slam" in Valley cross country - he won every thing. Not bad for one who doesn't particularly even like cross country. His first love is track - the 440 specifically. He likes to race about once a week, always runs to win and feels he can stay in top form all season rather than peaking for just a few big races.

His immediate goals center around winning at the State Meet and as a long range goal he has his sights set on the Olympics. Rest is an important aspect of Larry's training. "Early to bed, about 8:30. No later than 9:30 on week days." It's not hard to see that he takes track very seriously. However, it's fun. He says, "I love to run, it's exciting to compete and if you win it's a great thrill."

His studies are directed toward being a P.E. Instructor. Next year he hopes to run for Bakersfield College. "They have an outstanding coach and I have no desire to go away from home yet." After that Larry isn't sure, but he does he'll "run forever."

"My four years of high school I have been lucky to have the best high school coach in the country - I'm a workout griper during cross country but Mr. Wren keeps striving until I finally get my workouts all done. I love to run races were I'm able to push myself to my fullest ability and if Mr. Wren didn't push me I wouldn't be able to; plus he talks our races to us until we all have a great desire to be winners."

**TYPICAL WEEKS WORKOUT**  
Monday: 8X880(80 pace), 10X440(jog 110), 10X440(jog 55). Tuesday: 6 miles(36 min.), 10X440(220 jog). Wednesday: 15X660(75-80 pace, jog 440). Thursday: 15X44(3 sets of 5), Friday: race. Saturday: 1 hour easy run.

## VALLEY VIEWS

Last month High Sierra Track Club runner, Rich Petersen, and Bill Flodberg went on a 25 mile run into Mineral King while wearing signs which read "Save Mineral King." It took 4:35 to climb the 7,000 feet from Hwy 198 to the Ranger Station in Mineral King Valley. "The idea was to attract attention to the effort to preserve this area," said Rich.... Those of you who saw the USTFF Meet at Woodward Park will have to agree that it was a very good quality meet - Fresno State did an excellent job of hosting this run. If the Nat. AAU Meet hadn't been the following week in San Diego the race would have been even better.... Speaking of the USTFF Meet we saw at least four Valley coaches running right up there: Cliff Clark (Merced HS), Dale Opp (Corcoran HS), Bobby Fries (Fresno CC) and Len Thornton (Sierra JHS).... VTF's subscription list continues to grow, it now includes many colleges and national publications (Fresno State, Fresno City, Fresno Pacific, Bakersfield, Westhills, Modesto, Cal State Hayward, UCLA, San Fernando Valley St., Westmont College; Track and Field News, Runner's World, Women's Track and Field World, Letterman Magazine - and were just getting started). So, coaches, send in those results and news items - your team deserves publicity and exposure VTF can give it.

Two outstanding Valley Area high school runners ran the recently completed cross country season while suffering with hernias, Bruce Caputo (Clovis) and John Virden (Lemoore). Neither wanted to miss their senior cross country season so put off operations until after the Valley Meet.... Some early workout marks from Fresno State (11-10): 660 - Workintin 1:21.7(52.6), George 1:23.9 (53.0), Oldham 1:30.7(58), Sazana 1:30.9(59). 35# Wt. Throw - Tice 54'9", Giroux 40'2". Shot - Giroux 47'4", Workintin 44'5". Discus - Koldenburg 195, Tice, 144, Warkintin 140'5".... The N.A.I.A. District III voted to hold it's District Cross Country Championships in Fresno next year. This track season Fresno Pacific will host the District Decathlon Champs.

Fernie Montinez put on the First Annual Fresno Road Race on Nov. 27 (we'll have the results next month). The Valley needs more individuals who are willing to take on the initiative to host a road race. If you are interested contact Jerry Hobbs, Cent. Calif. Assoc. of AAU, 15616 Ave. 329, Ivanhoe 93235 for sanctions and to be put on the Valley

schedule (before Jan. 1, to be on '72 schedule).... Some late results: The Valley's Cliff Clark placed 16th (30:22) in the Nat. AAU X-C Meet. Merced's Junior ace, Dave Taylor, placed 67th in what has been called the best field ever assembled for a US Nat. cross country meet. Dave's time was an excellent 31:33 for the hilly 10,000 meter course. Taylor beat many national class runners (Juris Luzens 68, Steve Savage 70, Phil Ryan 79, Barry Brown 83) and finished just a few strides behind Fullerton great, Mark Covert. Florida TC was the team winner with N. California's West Valley TC placing second ahead of Oregon TC and the Pacific Coast Club.... Why isn't there a State Cross Country Meet? The Valley would be the ideal location for such an event - there aren't many courses more suitable than Woodward Park. If you are interested in being on a committee to get some wheels turning contact VALLEY TRACK AND FIELD editor.

All-Comers Track Meets: This winter, the Northern California Track & Field Assoc. will again conduct a series of meets at the College of San Mateo, beginning the weekend of Dec. 4 and again on the following Saturdays: Dec. 11, 18, Jan. 8, 15, and 29. Field events start at 11:30 am and running events at noon. The entry fee is 50¢ and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " spikes or flats are required on the all-weather track. Showers and lockers are available but the athlete will have to supply his own towel and lock. The 60 yd., 220 yd., 440 yd., 880 yd., Mile, 60 yd. HH, LJ, TJ, HJ, PV, SP, and Discus will be held in both the open and high school divisions. In addition, there will be the javelin and 3 mile (open) and 2 mile (high school). Requests for special events, other than those mentioned, must be submitted ten days in advance and be sufficiently competitive to warrant adding them. # Who are Those Guys?

Last month VALLEY TRACK AND FIELD gave an indication that Captain and Coach Cliff Clark (we called him Bill - sorry) along with Coach Cuchna were really putting something together in the Merced High Cross Country Team. Coach Clark feels, "that they are the toughest team (HS) from Bakersfield to Sacramento, ie in the 'Valley.'" After reading this feature on the Merced team you may agree.

First of all, Clark is truly a qualified coach and judge of performance as he is presently a National Class runner himself. His times last spring were: mile - 4:05.8, 2 mile - 9:01.2, Steeple - 8:40.2, 3 mile - 13:46.6, and 6 mile - 28:57. These were all early season times as he was injured in the West Coast Relays and missed out on the end-of-the-season marks. He considers himself a "track-nut" and coaches the Merced cross country team as "a hobby." His first year, 1969, there were 13 boys out for Merced cross country, they now have 67 out and that's after the normal attrition losses.

The Merced harriers follow a reduced version of their Coach's training, about 80 miles per week. "They train hard, but they run because they love it."

Last season's undefeated record, including Sophomore and Junior wins predicted that the Bears would be tough in the Varsity this year. This year's Varsity did go undefeated except for Mt. Pleasant (San Jose) and Mira Loma at the Sacramento Invitational. They have since beaten Mira Loma on several occasions and would like another shot at Mt. Pleasant. "We pride ourselves on pulling wins in the big, late season races, I think that's the only way to do it and be best," says Coach Clark. "We just train right through early season races, regardless of how much we may want a win."

The main thrust this year comes from Junior thinclad Dave Taylor. He's the greatest prep potential that Cliff Clark has ever seen. Taylor's best track times are 9:23 for two miles and 14:33.4 for three. This season he has clocked 14:12.2 on a three mile course that his coach and three other area coaches are convinced is an accurate three miles. This is only Dave's second year of running, he was a golfer before (high 70's), and he's also, a straight "A" student. He hopes to run in a few indoor meets this winter - watch out for Dave Taylor - we'll be hearing much more about him.

Number one spot on the team is the only stable position as the rest are exchanged between the rest of the squad. 9:39 two miler, Mark Galeazzi (one of the two Seniors) had a season best three mile cross country time of 14:47. Hal Luna (9:52 two miler) hit a 14:52 season best, Dennis Briceno's (9:44 two miler) best was 15:06, Larry Butler's (9:59 two miler) 15:15, Mike Hagerman (10:05 two miler) 15:16, Tom Tyra and Steve Potet had bests of 15:24 and 15:34 respectively. Tyra is the only other Senior.

This year the Merced dream came true - the Bears won the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section Varsity Championship; and it was a very solid win (see results elsewhere in this issue). They also won the Sophomore race, which means Merced will be up top for quite awhile.

Who are those guys? Those guys are young men who have learned, from their Coach, the real joys of running and training hard and, as a consequence, they win.
