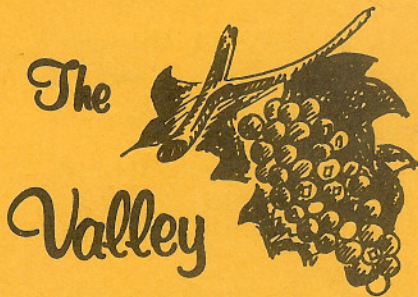

High Sierra is sponsoring a Summer run to the Olympic Trials. Departure is set for June 24th from the Pacific College track. The run will take 5 days (relay style) for the trip to Eugene. The Trials last 10 days and they will drive home July 10th. They will be camping out and generally keeping expenses as low as possible. At Sacramento they will hook up with a group from Napa for the rest of the trip and be collecting money donated by the various Kiwanis Clubs along the way to be given to the US Olympic Committee on the opening day of the Trials. MEET VALLEY COACH

Cameron Ostrand of Reedley High School: For the past decade Reedley High has consistently produced some of the finest individuals, as well as teams, in the Valley. The man behind that consistency and excellence is Coach Cameron Ostrand. Coach Ostrand doesn't like to talk about himself and it took awhile to get the following information about him. VALLEY TRACK AND FIELD has found him to be a very interesting and dynamic person - we thought our readers would also be interested in knowing more about this outstanding coach in the Valley.

Cameron J. Ostrand was born in Oakland, Nebraska. He attended Oakland High School and Rosalie High School, both in Nebraska. In high school he participated in football, basketball and track; and earned "all conference end" and "basketball captain" awards. The football team went two years undefeated.

At Nebraska State Teachers College "Cam" was a member of the college boxing team, winning the "Midwest Golden Gloves" as a middleweight; as well as running the quarter and throwing the javelin in track.

During his time in the Army he was fortunate to play on the Fort Knox football team and later represented Fort Sam Houston in the All Army Boxing Tournament and Fourth Army Track Meet.

After the service "Coach" was added to the beginning of Ostrand for the first time as he was appointed head football, basketball, and track coach at Walthill High, 1954 to 1956. While earning his M.S. degree at Colorado University Coach Ostrand served as head frosh and assistant varsity track coach under Frank Potts. Upon receiving the M.S. at C.U., Centralia Junior College in Washington became the new home for the young coach, as he held the head football and basketball positions from 1957 to 1958.

Coach Ostrand settled in Reedley in 1958 and has been head track and cross country mentor ever since. In 1959 he was also line football coach at Reedley College where his future wife was a teacher. They have now been married 12 years and have a 10 year old daughter, Sheri Lyn. When the "Coach" isn't at a meet the family enjoys horseback riding together, and flying with the Reedley Tiger Flight Club.

The Reedley Pirates won the Valley Varsity Track Championship in 1965 and the Class "B" Championship this past '72 season. In cross country they have won the Valley Varsity title twice ('69 & '70) as well as being runner-up to East Bakersfield in 1964. In 1968 and 1970 they won the Frosh-Soph Valley Meet.

Some of Coach Ostrand's coaching highlights while at Reedley include "winning the 1965 Valley Track Meet and the 1969 Valley Cross Country Meet. These two teams were cinderella teams that blossomed out in the "big meet." The 1965 track team did not get one first place in the Valley Meet, but still won with placing points to beat Edison for the Valley Track Championship. In 1969 the varsity cross country team did not have a senior on the team - it was all sophomores and juniors with one freshman."

He feels his greatest thrill thus far as a coach "was to have the privilege of coaching Pete Romero for three reasons: (1) he was a great competitor, (2) he was a model athlete for others to look up to and respect, (3) he was the greatest example of what hard training and work will do to provide results in competition for those dedicated few who work for a long range goal. Pete was a boy who truly appreciated the help he received and took advantage of track to secure an education and do what he dreamed of doing as a senior. Pete Romero as a frosh-soph had four "F"s on his record. Today he is teacher-head cross country-assistant track coach at Belaire High School in El Paso, Texas."

It would be impossible to list all of the outstanding individuals Coach Ostrand has worked with and helped, but to name just a few to refresh the memory: Dale Schmidt, Charles Wise, Pete Romero, Bill Blanchard, Carlos Bravo, Harry Nicholas, Roger Trujillo, Max Drake, Jaime Huerta, Don Kimura, etc., etc. Two top individuals on this year's team are: Fernando Huerta at 14-2 in the pole vault, and junior miler Mike Montoya at 4:21.9

As for coaching philosophies Coach Cameron Ostrand states that, "Dedication, determination, and desire are necessary to be a winner. Success or achievement has more value and feeling if you have to work for it. So practice hard on these principles in whatever you do and your day and life will be more satisfying."
