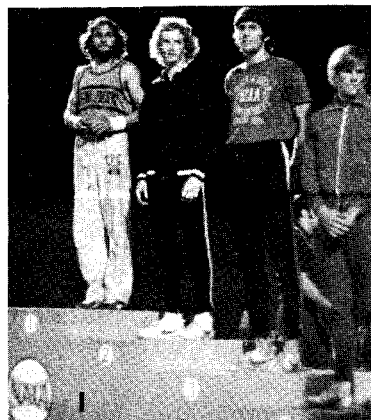
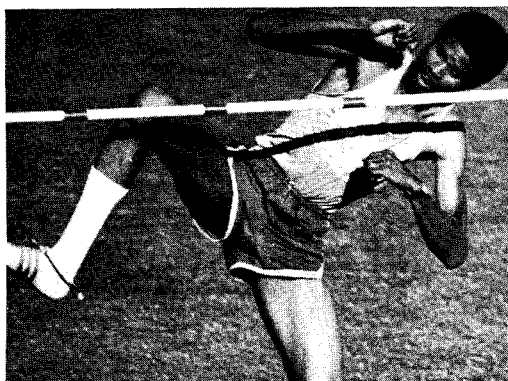

## MEET VALLEY COACH

**JIM WREN** of West High School in Bakersfield: The Valley Champion this year was West High, and their coach was Jim Wren.

Jim is a native of the Valley. He attended Arvin High School where he was All-League in football and basketball, plus league champion in the mile in 1955. He then attended Bakersfield College where he ran cross country and track. At the end of his second season of track at Bakersfield College he received the "Most Inspirational" Award. The following year Jim went on to Sacramento State. While there, he was selected "Most Outstanding Cross Country Runner" for 1959.

Jim has been at West High for eight years, where his teams have compiled a very impressive record. In dual meets his track teams have a compiled 26-7 won-loss record in the South Yosemite League. But his cross country teams have compiled a more impressive 40-4 won-loss record for cross country dual meets in the SYL and the SSL. His fine teams have produced four league championships in cross country and have given West two runnerup honors in the SYL track (1971, 1972) as well as this years Valley and League Titles.

Some of the outstanding members on this year's championship team were: Alex Hinzo in the two mile - 9:34.3; Tom Andrews in the 120 HH - 13.8, 440 - 48.0, and triple jump - 49-4; Joel Andrews in the 180 LH - 18.8, 220 - 21.8, long jump - 22-9; Rodney Palla in the discus - 173-7; and Bill Muxlow in the shot put - 57-7. Jim has also produced some Valley Champions over the past years, which include Larry Boen (440, 880), Phil Foster (880), Chris Glover (100), Tom Andrews (440), and Joel Andrews (LH and 220).

What is Jim's personal coaching goal? He tells us "I never want a runner to look back ten years later and think what he could have done if only his coach had worked him harder. I want him to realize whatever he didn't do was not because of physical conditioning. One of my basic philosophies is to teach kids that hard work does have its rewards."

Every coach has his favorite event. Since Jim has a distance background, most people would expect Jim to say that he enjoys coaching the distance men the most. But anyone who follows track wouldn't be at all surprised to find that his favorite event is the Mile Relay. The reason? His answer: "This event requires not only a great individual effort but a feeling of responsibility by each member to his other teammates. It demands great unity to have a good mile relay. It takes a supreme effort out of all four runners at the same time to win the big races." And, West has won quite a few of the "Big

Races." They were Valley Champs in the mile relay in 70, 71, and 72. But the 71 team was the most impressive of them all, placing second in the State Meet and ranking third in the nation. This team has the all time Valley mark of 3:14.9.

Next year Jim will be coaching only cross country, after a very successful career as head track coach. He tells us, "This is my last year as the track coach at West High. It has been a great thrill coaching track and working with such fine young men. Not only in ability, but attitudes as well. I leave with a great many enjoyable memories."

This will probably give the necessary time to spend with his family, which include his son, Jimm 13, and his daughter, Whitney 9. Plus time to enjoy his hobbies, camping and playing softball.

## MEET VALLEY ATHLETE

**ZENAS MORENO:** Senior, Mt. Whitney High School, Visalia. 5-9, 120 pounds. Born September 24, 1955 at Visalia, California.

**BEST MARKS:** 100 - 11.0; 220 - 24.9; 440 - 52.6r; 880 - 2:00.2; mile - 4:21.1; two mile - 9:46.3; six mile - 32:00; one hour run - 10 miles, 1201 yards; marathon - 2:59. Coached by Doug Rudolf.

**TRAINING:** Twice a day, six days a week, ten months a year. Long distance runs of 7-10 miles during the summer. Mid season begins light intervals emphasizing pace and stride. Late season concentration on short quick intervals with large recovery.

One runner that can consistently be counted on to be up in the money in Valley cross country and track competitions is Mt. Whitney's Zenas Moreno. But, success hasn't come easy for Zenas; he's earned it through miles of hard work. He started his running career at Divisadero Junior High School where he placed an unimpressive 25th in the junior varsity race at the league meet. Upon reaching high school he managed a 17:01 in his first two mile race for Mt. Whitney. "I began to like running because I was on the team and I belonged to something that was always on the move. The first three weeks were murder at Mt. Whitney, but by the end of the season I had taken off 5.5 minutes from my two mile time(12:06); at the annual awards banquet I recieved my most valued trophy "Most Improved" from Coach Roldan. That was the trophy that started it all. I found a running camp brochure on the coaches desk and on my own went to that camp (Singlers Springs) and in the fall of 1970 came back our number one varsity runner."

During his stay at Mt. Whitney Zenas picked up school records in the mile, two mile, six mile and one hour run as well as earning "Most Improved Cross Country Runner" in 1969, "All American Cross Country" 1970, 1971, 1972 (Mt. Whitney's highest award) and "Most Valuable Track Runner" in 1972 and 1973. He has competed in the CIF State Meet in 1973 and the 1972 National Explorer Olympics at Fort Collins, Colorado where he placed 9th in the cross country event and won the orienteering run.

Zenas competes in track "to keep in shape for cross country and because track gives me a chance to express myself in running." He feels he is ready to run 4:15 and would like to run in the Olympics before he's finished. For college he has chosen Brigham Young University, "because at BYU there's a special something that sets it apart from the rest of the colleges. After college I hope to help the community with some vital service."

During the summer months Zenas continues and likes to participate in a summer running camp or two. He's attended Singlers Springs Sports Camp in the Bay area, Olympia Sports Village in Wisconsin, and VanDellen's Running Camp in Woodlake. This summer he will be at Camp Crockett YMCA High Altitude Distance Runners Training Camp in Colorado. Aside from sports he enjoys chess, works at McDonalds, and is a student pilot currently lacking 10 hours before receiving his private pilot's license. He is also vice president of the school chess club, secretary of Explorer Post 308, and vice president of PTSA.

Mt. Whitney distance coach, Doug Rudolf, says of Zenas, "Based on what he has accomplished in high school Zenas is the finest distance runner that I have had the privelege of working with and I truly believe that he will go far." We agree and look forward to following Zenas Moreno during college.
