Pacific College has been publishing Valley Track and Field for almost three years now. As we evaluate the success of the newsletter in preparing for the fourth year it is obvious that it has had and will, probably, continue to have both success and failure. It is an attempt to serve a big need here in the Valley track world, yet it falls far short of the potential that could be realized by a track publication such as this.

The newsletter has been successful in communicating track information throughout the Central Valley. This success has been largely due to the faithful Valley track people who continue to send in results, schedules, articles and other track material. Thanks to all of you. It is you who make the newsletter even a little bit worth reading.

The failure of Valley Track and Field can basically be related to two factors. These two factors go hand-in-hand, each having a direct effect on the other. First, the small number of supporting subscriptions. Second, the amount of time it takes one person to type and put together each issue. Who subscribes to VTF? (1) Valley coaches, (2) Valley road racers, (2) College coaches outside the Valley interested in recruiting from the Valley. We've just about reached the maximum in the three areas above. Admittedly, if the quality of the newsletter were better more people would subscribe. Valley high school and college track men for the most part aren't interested in subscribing.

It takes about forty hours of work for me to put out each issue. It would take more hours to upgrade the quality. It is becoming increasingly difficult for me to give this amount of time to Valley Track and Field (as you've noticed by the increasing number of double issues). I appreciate that you've been patient with me so far, however, it is quite frustrating to do less than a good job.

So, what's the solution? There are two: (1) further cut back on the quality which will take less time and expense to publish, (2) increase the potential readership which will, supposedly, increase the number of subscriptions, and, therefore the amount of dollars coming in which can be used to hire a typist, and upgrade the quality of production. Right now I'm in the process of exploring the possibility of expanding VTF to cover all of California as CTF. Most reactions have been favorable, but many details must still be worked out. Let me know what you think about this.

## MEET VALLEY ATHLETES

CURT and CRAIG ELIA: Phaethon Track Club. 5'9", 155 pounds. Born June 13, 1950 in Pasadena, California. 23 years old. Graduate students at Fresno State University.

BEST MARKS: Curt: Six Mile-30:17, Ten Mile-52:30, Two Mile-9:40. Craig: Six Mile-30:30, Ten Mile-52:50.

TRAINING: Twice a day, six days a week, eleven months a year. 70-80 miles per week. Most training Long Slow Distance with some sharpening interval running. Coached by Red Estes.

In describing Curt Elia you'll find you've also given an accurate description of Craig Elia. They weigh the same, are the same height, run the same, train the same, look the same, and were born on the same day - which makes sense since they are identical twins. They attended Glendale High School where they both won league championships in cross country and track on separate occasions. At Citrus Junior College they were both cross country team captains as well as most valuable runner. The twins completed their college running at Fresno State where they were the backbone of the Bulldog distance crew. Last year, running for Phaethon Track Club, they were both selected to the "All Valley Distance Running Team."

In the past Curt and Craig have been accused of each only running half of a race with nobody able to tell them apart; actually both are outstanding Valley distance runners in their own rights and are contenders in any race they enter as was demonstrated in the recent Visalia Ten Miler where they went 1-2, both under the course record. They both emphasize a solid background of many miles, lots of sleep, a good diet, and fruit juice on the day of a race.

The Elias are finishing up in the teacher credential program at Fresno State and will soon be sharing their talents with others as cross country and track coaches. They both plan to continue their own running as long as it remains enjoyable. Immediate goals for Curt are to improve upon his times, Craig wants to run a good marathon. Curt competes in track because, as he says, "I like the people one meets, and it gives me a great amount of satisfaction." Craig says, "I just like competing." Their favorite event is the road race and they like to compete one every week or two.

## MEET VALLEY COACH

ANDY DARBY: Wasco High School. If you don't know who Andy Darby is, then you don't know much about Valley track and field. Andy Darby has been the head track coach at Wasco High School for twenty years. During this 20 year dynasty his varsity track teams have won the South Sequoia League Championships in 1955, 1958, 1960, 1962, 1970, 1971, 1972, 1973. The Class B squad has won it eight times and the Class C seven times. In addition Darby coached the 1955 Wasco basketball team to an undefeated season all the way through the Valley Championships.

If the above list of championships is impressive the following list of individual champions is staggering. Here are just some of the track athletes fortunate enough to develop their talents under the guidance of Coach Darby at Wasco: Smithy Callahan(9.8, 21.5, 23-6); Harold Gaston(23-11 1/2); Bob Morrison(45-10 3/4); Sherrill Boyett(18.7, 14.2); Otis Hailey(7-1 1/4 at that time a national record); Steve Reimer(14.2, 18.9, 38.2); Lee Callahan(19.0, 21.2 220); Warren Maston(6-6); Gordon Brown(6-6); Jim Beasley(13-10); Sammy Garcia(F-S Valley Champ in cross country). State Meet Performers: Smithy Callahan(100, 220, LJ); Mac Ellis(HJ); Lowell Woodman(100, 220); Harold Gaston(LJ); Sherrill Boyett(HH, LH); Jim Beasley(PV); Otis Hailey(HJ); Lee Calahan(LH, 220); Warren Maston(HJ); Jim Miller(HH); Jim Penrose(DT); Gordon Brown(HJ); Steve Reimer(HH, LH); Gary Broom(HJ).

Andy Darby was born in Fresno, California. He attended Sanger High School(class of 1949) where he competed four years in football, track and baseball plus three years in basketball. He held school records in the shot and discus, as well as school intramural champion for three years. After high school he picked up the javelin at Fresno State and ranked fourth in the U.S. in that event(224-9). Upon graduation he continued to throw the javelin with the San Francisco Olympic Club along with other track standouts: "Bud" Held, Leo Long, and "Cy" Young. Andy completed his education with a Masters Degree at San Jose State.

Since coming to Wasco High Coach Darby has amassed a varsity won-loss record of 121-40, Class B 99-53, and Class C 105-52.

Coach Darby is an energetic, dynamic, outgoing individual who believes in himself and his methods and transfers this optimistic "can do" attitude to each and everyone of his athletes. If you've seen him at a meet you know he gets in as much of a workout as any athlete competing. He's dedicated and believes in track and expects no less from the Wasco trackmen.

Andy met his wife, Jackie, at Fresno State and has two daughters, Jeri 21, and Andi 19. He is presently athletic director, chairman of the boy's and girl's P. E. departments as well as head track and cross country coach. When he gets some spare time he enjoys recreational activities such as golf and badminton.

Although Wasco lost their string of SSL Championships in a close fought battle with Corcoran there were many outstanding performers on the team: Sammy Garcia(Jr)(4:27. 2, 9:35. 2); John Herrick(Sr)(14. 5, 20. 1); Carl Williams(Sr)(160-8, 10. 2, 23. 2); Billy Santillian(Jr)(LH, 440); Joe Aguerria(Jr)(440, 880); Danny Ruiz(So)(One-2 mile); Shawn Shambaugh(Fr)(880); Albert Munoz(Sr)(2 mile); Bob Brown(Sr)(HH); Ron Hunt(So)(PV).

When pressed to pick his greatest thrill as a track coach at Wasco High he admits, "This is a real tough one: I have had many... I get a big thrill every time one of my athletes improves on his performance, or makes the height on his last try for a position to the State Meet, hard to pick one, but I will name a few... Watching Jim Beasley break his pole 5 days before the valley meet, and then to come back and have an all time high of 13-10 for a valley record; Lee Callahan with a pulled hamstring all season to qualify for the state in the 180 LH; Jim Penrose winning the Golden West meet on his last throw; or winning the SSL Track Championships for 4 consecutive years; watching Otis Hailey make 6-8 for the first time; or watching Steve Reimer run the Intermediates in Chicago.

The Wasco track mentor has a philosophy that, "Everyone can do something... some have talent, some do not, some have to work harder than others if you try you will have some measure of success... you can't get first all of the time, somebody has got to get those 2nds., 3rds., etc... If you think you can do it, you will... develop a desire for

winning, you don't work to lose... strive for perfection... No alibis... try all the events and let the coach decide which is best for you... Track is a mental thing, all you need is 25% ability, the rest is up to you, you can do it, be positive at all times... Compete in all events that are assigned to you... you are expected to double and triple in events, if you run the hurdles you will also run the 440 and possibly high jump, if you run the sprints you will also have the long jump and relays. No one is ever cut from the squad... your appearance as well as your attitude reflect directly on your coach, teammates, school and community, therefore, act in a courteous and gentlemanly manner... develop pride in yourself, teammates school and community... There is more but it would take too much time, someday I intend to write a book on this plus techniques that I use for the various events."

Another highlight in Coach Darby's track career was attending the 1968 and 1972 Olympic Games of which he has hundreds of feet of movie film. He was also one of 300 coaches picked to attend a week at Sacramento(expenses paid) in a Track clinic. He has dedicated his life to helping young people through track and has been an inspiration to many.

### VALLEY WANDERINGS

January 27, Orange, California: WORLD MASTER'S MARATHON. 31. Bill Peck(Wasco) 2:57:54 (187 finishers, won by Ron Kurrle of the Beverly Hills Striders in 2:19:36).

March 24, San Martin, California: SAN MARTIN MARATHON. Perseverance finally paid off for Bill Peck, running his third marathon in three months, as he conquered a field of 26 starters and 23 finishers to win this race. Bill edged runner-up Gary Chilton by slightly over a minute as he was clocked in 2:52:14 in this Bay Area RRC sponsored event.

May 19, San Francisco, California, BAY TO BREAKERS. Plenty of Valley runners traveled to the world's largest race(4633 starters) across the city of San Francisco. Although the rest of the event was well organized, the size of the field overwhelmed the people in charge of the finish and only partial results are available. 
