His time was the best-ever by a freshman as he toured the three - mile course in 15:14.7. More than 400 runners, from freshmen to varsity seniors competed in the meet, including some of the best runners in Northern California.

The lean Terman frosh's time was better than 10 seconds below the next freshman, Vern Lewis of Homestead, and almost two minutes lower than his next Terman teammate. Terman placed second in frosh competition.
