Most Ever Make State Finals

Seven North Peninsula athletes-the most ever-qualified for the State High School track and field championships ta be held Friday and Saturday at Berkeley.

Six of them - three from San Mateo High School, two from Burlingame and one from Mills-qualified in the Central Coast Sectionals at Gunn High School in Palo Alto, and Serra's Jerry Tallon qualified in the North Coast Sectionals at Cal.

Burlingame's Randy Weil won both the high and low hurdles in his best times this season, a wind-aided 14.2 and a 19.1 in the lows.

THE PANTHERS' Steve De-Laet nabbed third place in the pole vault with a 13-9 effort.

San Mateo's Ted Lydon established one of the two meet records set at Gunn

when he ran the two mile in 9:27.5. 10.6 seconds under the mark set two years ago. The unbeaten Bearcat runner needed a fast closing sprint to win this one, however, as he was strongly challenged by Wilcox's Mike Gunion.

Bob Jordan of San Mateo won the long jump with a leap of 22-81/2, and Pete Boyko placed third in the shot with a 55-634 heave.

Another Mid Peninsula League standout, Randy White of Mills, was second in the 880 with his best clocking to date, a 1:55.7 that matched the winning time.

Burlingame won the team competition with 17 points. one better than Ravenswood and Fremont, San Mateo was fourth with 15, and Mills was 13th with eight.

Mills was fifth in Class B team scoring with 13 markers, as shotputter Dennis Gilchrist won with a toss of 49-534.

MEANWHILE at Berkeley. Jerry Tallon cracked the NCS 880 record with a time of 1:53.2. a full 1.6 seconds under the old standard set in 1964. Tallon easily defeated the rest of the field in running his best race of the year.
