

# Wells Sets <sup>5/9</sup> Vault Mark

SANTA CRUZ—Don Wells of King City jumped higher than any Central Coast prep pole vaulter this season with a 14-1 leap at the Santa Cruz Dad's Club Relays Saturday afternoon.

Wells' effort was 3½ inches higher than his previous area-leading best.

Seaside edged Watsonville 76-74 for the championship, followed by Santa Cruz and Salinas, each with 31 points. Watsonville was without the services of distanceman Bob Scurich, competing in an AAU meet at Sacramento.

In addition to Wells' pole vault, meet records were established by Watsonville's Ray Tagami with a 6-2½ high jump and by Seaside's mile relay, clocked in 3:25.4.
