Top Jump

Denny Rodgers of Los Altos leaped to the nation's longest prep triple jump effort Thursday with a 48-4³/₄ effort in the Knights' 101-30 victory over visiting Wilcox.

Four of Rodgers' five jumps surpassed the 47-5 Central Coast standard he set Saturday at the Blossom Hill Relays. His series was 47-7, 48-4¹/₂, 47-1, 48-4³/₄ and 48-2. Rodgers also won the long jump with a 22-11 effort.

Bill Chapman, running with tendonitis in his right leg, still was able to equal the Central Coast best in the 220 with a 21.6 clocking. Tim Lape of Wilcox was second in 21.9. Also getting 21.9 was Los Altos' Steve Pearson, though he was running exhibition.

Pearson also was credited with the second fastest area time in the low hurdles with a 19.4 effort.
