

Watsonville Tops

Prep Track List ^{3/21}

For the second straight year Watsonville is turning in perhaps the largest share of best individual efforts among Central Coast track and field teams.

Though sprinter Joe Richards has departed, the current crop of Wildcats boast another outstanding dashman in Mike Williamson who was credited with a 9.7 100-yard dash, .2 better than runnerup Gene Delk of Andrew Hill. In the 220, Williamson's best of 22.1 is only .1 off the area best.

Wildcat teammate Bob Scurich is the only individual with best times in two events. His reported 1:54.8 in the half-mile is nearly three seconds faster than that of runnerup John Lilly of San Carlos, while Scurich's 4:26 mile is 2.3 seconds faster than teammate Tom Leikam, who has the second fastest time.

Other Watsonville standouts include the 880 relay team, tied with Buchser for second behind Samuel Ayer's 1:30.2, and high jumper Ray Tagami, tied for second behind a 6-4 leap by Fremont's Mike Fleming.

Ayer's Earl Harris, one of the members of the relay quartet, also ranks first in the long jump at 22-11 and is tied for third in both the 220 and 100.

Rick Gendreau of Gunn has a wind-blown 14.8 high hurdle mark to his credit and teammate Rich Hunter leads all two-milers with a 9:41.3.

Prep Spikesters Vie In Regional Meets

Possessors of the season's best efforts in Central Coast track and field attempt to stay in contention for a berth in the state meet June 4 as they enter Regionals at four sites this weekend.

The three valley leagues get a head start Friday at Cupertino, with the remaining meets slated for Saturday.

Other Regional sites are Gunn, for the three Peninsula loops; Hollister, for the Mission Trail, Monterey Bay and Catholic Athletic Association; and Castro Valley, for the Mission Valley, Catholic League and other East Bay loops.

Entering the Regionals, the top times has one new leader, Jim Marshall of Ravenswood. Marshall clocked a 21.1 in the 220-yard dash Saturday at the South Peninsula League finals. The wind-aided effort was a half-second faster than the previous low held by a quartet of dashmen.

Several members of the listings failed to qualify for the Regionals. Among them is Pacific Grove's Johnny Johnson, national record holder in the long jump, who did not compete in the Mission Trail League finals at Gonzales Saturday.

Following Regional meets, qualifiers from the valley loops go to Gunn for the Central Coast Sectional, last stop before the state meet at Berkeley.

Light Shuffle For Track

Escaping the Blossom Hill Relays without much of a shakeup, the Central Coast listing of top prep track efforts nevertheless has three new leaders this week.

Only one of the changes came during the Relays, but it was a dandy, a 23-10½ long jump by Denny Rodgers of Los Altos. Rodgers also upped his pace-setting mark in the triple jump to 47-5, over a foot ahead of

second-place Jerry Jackson of Andrew Hill.

The other newcomers, Steve Wilhelm of Fremont and John Olmos of Mountain View, achieved their marks earlier in the week.

Wilhelm got off a 61-3¼ shot put to overtake previous leader Dale Carlin of Andrew Hill, who upped his personal best to 60-6½ the same day. Wilhelm's teammate, Al Richert, is third

at 56-0.

Olmos clocked a 21.6 in the 220-yard dash to tie the front-running standard of Watsonville's Mike Williamson. In the same race, Tim Lape of Wilcox was given an official time of 21.8 to move past a quartet of 21.9 sprinters.
