# Welcome C. I. F.

Gridley, celebrated for its irrigated colonies, lies in the southern part of Butte county, 70 miles north of Sacramento approximately 170 miles from San Francisco. Population of the city, close to 2000 in the 1930 census, is now estimated at 2500. Diversified farming, with rice culture and peach growing the two major phases, have made the community prosperous and progressive. The city boasts its own municipal power and water system and has park and recreation facilities not equalled by many cities much larger.

The Libby, McNeill & Libby cannery, located in Gridley is the largest straight-line cannery in the world. During the summer some fifteen hundred people are employed in this cannery. Other hundreds in the orchards.

A plentiful supply of gravity water for irrigation has aided in the establishment of a solid agricultural community.

The Gridley Community Club, with a membership of more than 350, has established a reputation as one of the most successful organization of its kind in the state. Many community betterment projects have been carried out by the club, and its annual banquet attracts the notable figures of the state.

The school plants of the community are most modern. The high school is but a few years old and a new grammar school, to be occupied for the first time in September, is attracting attention as one of the most modern structures in the northern part of the state.

The high school athletic field is rated one of the best in the Sacramento Valley, with a fast track and a splendid turf.
