Scoring—Relays: winning team 5 points, losing team none; (alumni 440 relay walk and freshman medley relay events are exhibitions and do not count in point score); field events: aggregate winner 4 points, individual winner 1 point.

Rules Concerning Field Events—Five men represent each team. The marks of the four best are totaled and the winner thus determined. Each man gets three trials only in the shot, discus, javelin, and broad jump. In the pole vault and high jump, each competitor is given six trials only. He may take them at any time but after he has completed his sixth effort he is through with competition for the day.
