

# San Mateo Nips Salinas In NCS II Track And Field Trials, Lions 4th

San Mateo surged from behind to nip Salinas by 1/12 of a point to capture the North Coast Section II track meet yesterday afternoon at Salinas. The Bearcats totaled 38-1/12 digits to 38 for Salinas. Lincoln topped local schools as the Lions finished fourth behind Pacific Grove.

Salinas reversed things in the lightweight meet as the Cowboys won with 37 points. Santa Clara scored 30 1/2 points for second spot. Willow Glen was the top all-around local cinder crew as the Rams finished fifth in the varsity and seventh in the lightweights.

Santa Clara Valley preps grabbed four firsts and tied for another in yesterday's action. Lincoln's Don Bowden came from behind to best Pacific Grove's Bob Fry in the half-mile. The Lion star set a new meet record of 1:59.7.

In the feature mile race Santa Clara's Bill Wilson nipped Lick's Gary Antes at the finish line to post a 4:38.7 mile. Lincoln's Frank Wulfange ran one of his best races as the Lion grabbed fourth spot.

San Jose's Chuck Hightower and Fremont's Dick French were

other valley winners. Hightower cleared 12 ft., 6 in. in the pole vault, while French flipped the platter 135 ft., 9/8 in. Two other

locals, Lincoln's Dick Darwin and San Jose's Dick Andres, tied for fourth in the vault at 11 feet.

The High Jump was all Santa

Clara Valley as four lads from this county tied for first. Lincoln's Jack Graf, Willow Glen's Frank Herrmann, Mountain View's Art Bell, and Lick's Jerry Tatro all cleared 5 ft., 9 in.

Although local tracksters did well, Salinas' Mel Robertson and Pacific Grove's Fred Nelson stole the show. Robertson ripped off wins in the 100 and 220 in times of 10.1 and 22.2. Robertson was pressed by Charlie Collins of King City in both races, while Lincoln's Bob Knoth was but a yard behind as he took a third in the furlong.

Nelson unofficially recorded the best broad jump mark in the State as the little Breaker leaped 23 ft., 7 in. on his first jump. Willow Glen's Herrmann was forced to settle for second. Nelson also placed third in the century.

Two Willow Glen lads and Salinas' Eddie King were the whole show in the lightweight division. The Rams' Bob Walrath ran the best 330 of his life to break the tape in 36.7 for a new meet record. Ron Frizzell vaulted 11 ft., 6 in. to break the pole vault standard. King, only a sophomore, burned up the track to win the 660 in the remarkable time of 1:24.1 and the 150 yard dash in 15.6.
