The California Interscholastic Federation, hereby dedicates the 1958 North Coast Section Track and Field meet to Hi Jennings.

Hi Jennings, who came to Berkeley High School as Chairman of the Physical Education Department in 1920 and held this position until 1951, has devoted a great part of his life to the service of youth. He was also the Secretary of the Alameda County Athletic League, and served as a member of the Section Board of Managers for NCS from 1920 to 1937, acting as chairman of baseball, tennis, track, and swimming.

In May, 1937, Mr. Jennings became the Secretary-Treasurer of the North Coast Section, California Interscholastic Federation.

He served as the California Representative on the National Federation Football Rules Committee in 1949.

While at Berkeley, Mr. Jennings was the Director of the Berkeley Lions Club, and a member of Masons and Elks.

Not content to sit on the sideline, Hi Jennings has devoted much time to community service, including Chairmanship of the Petaluma Annual Red Cross Membership Drive, Director of the Petaluma Chamber of Commerce, and the Parks and Recreation Commission, Director of the Sonoma County Heart Association, and as Director of the Petaluma Boys Club.

The teenagers and coaches of California sincerely appreciate all the wonderful, enriching things that Hi Jennings has done to make our lives easier and more fulfilling.

Hi Jennings by his devotion and untiring support has shown the highest caliber of service to his fellow man. We humbly give thanks to a great man.

### INSTRUCTIONS TO COACHES AND ATHLETES

1. At the end of each race run in lanes, walk back in your lane to the starting line and stand until dismissed. As soon as the place winners have been determined, those boys should report to the victory stand for their medals.
2. After completing your events, do not stand around the field events or the finish line. Go into stands or stay on east side of track.
3. Report to Clerk on first call for your event.
4. Coaches please make every effort to keep your athletes off the field.
5. All shots and discus are to be weighed and stamped before competition starts. The Weigh-in station is under the bleachers at the north end of the field.
6. The 330 and 440 yd. runs will be run in lanes all the way from a staggered start.
7. The 440 yd. relay will be run in lanes all the way from a staggered start at the head of the straightaway.
8. The 880 yd. relay will run in lanes until the 3rd man clears his baton passing section, then he may break for the pole.
9. The 660, 880, 1320, and Mile runners will start from a staggered start at the head of the straightaway, remaining in lanes until around the first turn at which time they may break for the pole.

NOTE:

There is no time schedule except for starting time of the meet. Then we will follow the regular N. C. S. schedule of events and as quickly as one race is completed the next scheduled race will start.
