M-A flash also sets SPAL record in 220

Dick Burns, Willie Waller and Jim Cheatham led Menlo-Atherton to a smashing day of record-breaking performances in the South Peninsula Athletic League track and field trials at Stanford's Angell Field yesterday.

Burns, who added the title of SPAL's fastest runner to his previously earned laurels as the Peninsula's fastest prep runner, zipped to a 9.7 clocking in his heat of the 100-yard dash and then came back to win a heat of the 220-yard dash in 21.8.

BOTH MARKS ARE new standards for the SPAL. The old mark for the century was 9.9 racked up two seasons ago by Ernie Stevenson of Cubberley.

The furlong mark was 22 flat by Jim Cudworth of Sequoia, also in 1958. Burns had no competition in either race.

His margin of victory in the 100, over second place Fred Benjamin of Cubberley, was at least 10 yards at the finish.

The 220 was the same story. Burns, off to a slow start, caught the others at the 100 yard mark and breezed home in front by five yards.

The Waller-Tod Ragsdale 440-yard duel never came off. They ran in different heats. But still Ragsdale couldn't win.

HE LOST TO M-A's Hugh Smith who ran the fastest quarter mile of his career to win in 50.7.

Waller won his race in 49.4—a new SPAL record. He took off like a rocket and finished the same way. His margin of victory was at least 20 yards.

Cheatham picked up three places in next week's finals. He was the best of the broad jump qualifiers with a leap of 21-9 $\frac{3}{4}$ and also made the grade in the 100 and 220-yard dashes.

The other top marks of the day were divided among the other six competing schools. Don Castle, Cubberley's powerful little weightman, shattered the SPAL standard with a mighty 154-foot discus toss. He also qualified for the shot-put finals.

PALY'S DISTANCE runners came through as expected. Ric Brady topped the half mile qualifiers in 1:58.7 and then both Mike Lehner and Mike Chilton won a heat of the mile. Lehner's time of 4:24.2 was another "no competition" effort. He should be able to chop at least five seconds of the time against his teammate Chilton next week.

Henry McGuire, as fine a B runner as their is in the league, outran the 330-yard field with a sizzling 35.8 performance.
