

Marks Fall In Western Girls' Track

Veteran Cherrie Parrish Sherrard, star performer for the Laurel Track Club of San Francisco, set two records and equaled another in the Western U. S. Women's Track and Field Games at Castlemont High School in Oakland yesterday.

Even so, Mrs. Sherrard only slightly overshadowed the performance of 15-year-old Denise Paschal, Laurel's rising young star who won two events and equalled one record in the final tuneup for the National AAU meet, which will be held here in July.

Mrs. Sherrard won the 80 meter hurdles and 200 meter dash in Western record time and tied the mark in the 100 meters. Miss Paschal prevailed in the 50 meter hurdles for age 14-17 competitors, and she equalled the standard in the high jump.

Other outstanding performers in the Pacific Association sanctioned event were Collette Freitas of Santa Clara Valley Track Club, Gretchen Fallin of Concord, Lynda Bradshaw and Joanne Slaten of the Oakland Oakettes, Lucille Brown and Cassandra Brooks of Laurel, and Nancy Palmer, Susan Pfleiger and Pat Winslow of San Mateo Girls AC. Miss Winslow set a new Pacific Association record in the shotput with a toss of 44-3 1/4.

Laurel took the team title in the women's division, with the Oakettes nabbing honors in the 14-17 age group and the overall title.


