

Figueroa runs 9.5 hundred

John Figueroa of Sunnyvale High School may have a sprint clocking that means something this time.

There was hardly a whisper of a breeze as Figueroa zoomed 100 yards on the Wilcox High School track Thursday afternoon in 9.5.

It's the fastest time on the Peninsula this year and perhaps the fastest ever by a prep from this area.

Two weeks ago, aided by wind, Figueroa ran 100 yards in 9.6. The previous official fastest 100 for any Peninsula runner was 9.6 by Dick Brown of Lincoln High School in San Jose in the early '50s.

Figueroa also won the 440-yard dash in 51.2 but all his speed

couldn't keep Wilcox from winning the meet 68-63.

Despite the excellent time for Figueroa, the hurdlers really were the stars for the day.

Rich McClung of Sunnyvale posted the fastest time on the Peninsula in the 120-yard high hurdles with a 14.7 clocking. Steve Boice of Los Altos did 14.8.

In the high hurdles, three were under 20 seconds. The fastest was Simon Rapanut of Wilcox at 19.3. He edged McClung by one-tenth of a second.

Boice won his low hurdles race against Homestead by clocking a 19.4.

Los Altos won the meet 94-37. In other meets, Fremont got a double sprint win from Gary Ma-

han to beat Awalt 73 1-3 to 57 2-3, Cupertino buried Santa Clara 89-42, and Buchser defeated Mountain View.

Among the outstanding performances were a 6-6½ high jump by Max Lowe of Awalt, a 4:25.8 mile for Joe Biber of Buchser, a 56-1½ shot put by Vic Martindale of Los Altos, and a 159-8 discus throw for Larry Dixon of Wilcox.

Sophomore Terry Pennell of Los Altos threw the discus 159-4 for another very good mark.

The best B marks were an 11-4½ pole vault by Larry Hill Los Altos, and a 1:27.6 660 by Larry Werner of Los Altos.

In Class C Ron Dickson of Mountain View set a school record in winning the 660 in 1:29.0

and Ernie Escalante of Buchser did the 330 in 37.5.

Wind helps SCVAL runners

Tailwinds aided some Santa Clara Valley Athletic League runners and jumpers Thursday but the breeze blew so hard at Sunnyvale that the Jets' meet with Buchser was postponed until today.

The best times were turned in at the Los Altos-Fremont meet, but the most interesting meet was Mountain View's 66-65 final event win over Homestead.

Mountain View won the relay and took first and second in the discus to edge Homestead. However, the losing Mustangs had the outstanding individual performer in the meet. Clark Smith broad jumped 22-1½, the longest jump ever made at Mountain View High School.

The best individual effort for Mountain View was a 50-3¾ shot-put by Jeff Bautista of Mountain View.

Gary Mahan of Fremont whipped to wind-aided times of 9.9 and 21.7 for the Indians but Los Altos won the meet 78-56.

The top performer for Los Altos was hurdler Steve Boice who won in 19.8 and 15.1. The wind helped him.

Max Lowe stopped jumping at 6-4 after he had first place cinched in the Awalt-Cupertino meet. Lowe suffered a tendon injury in his left — or takeoff — foot and stopped jumping.

He had to go that high to beat John Ramey of Cupertino who cleared 6-2. Ramey has a best of 6-4 this season while Lowe came within one quarter inch of the national prep record when he cleared 6-9½ against Santa Clara High School two weeks ago.

Coach Phil Casaroli of Awalt said that Lowe would take it easy on the injured foot for the next couple weeks so he will be able to compete in the big meets in May and June.

One of the best B marks of the day was a 15.5 in the 150-yard dash by Jim Marquez of Mountain View.

In the other varsity meet, Wilcox defeated Santa Clara 86½-39½. The best mark was a 56-3¾ shot by Bill Dickson of Wilcox.

Senior misses three tries at U.S. prep record

Senior Max Lowe of Awalt High School in Mountain View has his sights set on the national prep high jump record today, after leaping 6-9 $\frac{1}{4}$ in a dual meet Thursday against Santa Clara.

Lowe, who stands 6-11 $\frac{1}{2}$, missed equaling the national prep record by three-quarters of an inch. The national mark of 6-9 $\frac{3}{4}$ was set in 1956 by Walt Mangham, New Castle, Pa., and tied in 1962 by Dick Jones, Bakersfield.

Lowe had three shots at 6-10 $\frac{1}{2}$, missing badly on his first two efforts but just clipping the bar on his last try.

Previously, Lowe's best leap had been 6-5 $\frac{1}{2}$, established in the 1962 state meet. He missed most of last year because of injuries.

Lowe's effort highlighted host Awalt's easy 101-30 conquest of Santa Clara in varsity competition.

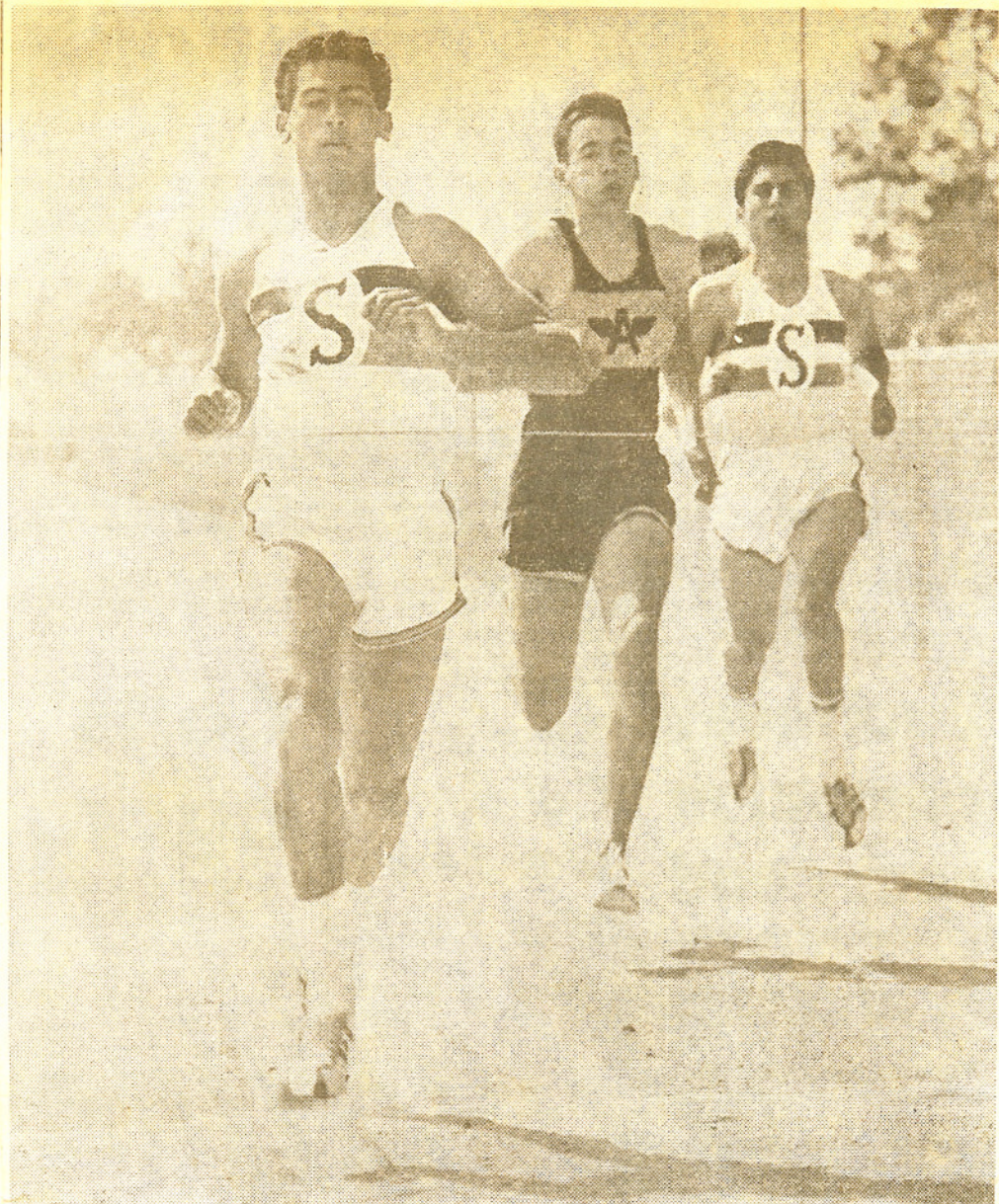

Sprinters SCVAL stars

In approximately the same amount of time it is taking you to read this paragraph today, Gary Mahan of Fremont High School ran 100 yards yesterday.

And by the time you finish reading this sentence, John Figueroa of Sunnyvale High School could have run 220 yards which is faster than any other prep runner in Northern California has done it this season.

The sprinters were the stars in Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track meets Thursday afternoon.

Mahan won the 100, 220 and broad jump as Fremont crushed Buchser 105-26. Mahan's time in the 100-yard dash was 9.6. He breezed home an easy winner.

There was a wind behind him which had to help.

Mahan's 22-7/4 in the broad jump also had the help of the breeze but the marks are noteworthy even if recorded in a wind tunnel.

Figueroa led Sunnyvale to a 70-61 win over Awalt as he won the 100 (9.7), the 220 (21.0) and ran on the Jets' relay team that placed first and decided the meet.

Figueroa got a bad start in the 100 and still coasted to a wind-blown 9.7. Two of the four watches had him in 9.6, another in 9.7 and the fourth in 9.8.

In the 220, "Fig" got an excellent start and ran well all the way. He won by almost 10 yards, an extremely wide margin for so short a race.

Two watches stopped at 2.09, another said 2.10 and the fourth 2.11 for that race. The middle watch of the lot is used as the official time.

No wind gauge was on hand to record the intensity of the breeze.

Figueroa's time for the 220 is

the fastest in Northern California this season for a prep. The previous best was 2.12.

Awalt turned in some outstanding performance of its own. Four Spartan broad jumpers did 21-6 or better. The winner was Pete Wilson at 22-10. Guy Eustice was second. He also was past 22 feet. Jay Bathurst and Joe Martin jumped 21-8 and 21-6.

Max Loew of Awalt set a stadium record in the high jump when he leaped 6-6 1/4. He just missed at 6-8.

Chuck Smart was the star for Los Altos. He has been out for five weeks with a leg injury but showed no ill effects of the lay-off.

He threw the discus 183-6 and the shot 59-3. The discus throw is the best in California this year and among the top 20 throws of all time for preps.

John Boyer of Los Altos turned in the fastest half mile time in the league this year when he won in 1:58.9.

In the other meets, Cupertino defeated Mountain View 90-41, and Wilcox topped Homestead 85-45.

The best B marks of the day were a 1:26.7 660 by Larry Werner of Los Altos, a 9.0 and 13.8 hurdles double by Steve Pensing of the Fremont B's, and a 108-3 discus throw by Los Altos C Steve Davis.
