



Oregon State University

Oregon State University is the oldest state-supported institution of higher learning in Oregon. It is now in its 96th year with a record enrollment of approximately 10,533. This is 1000 more than a year ago and 2000 more than 1960. OSU is one of the nation's Land-Grant Colleges, started by the Morrill Act of 1862 to make educational opportunities available to all Americans who have the will and ability to learn.

OSU schools of study, in order of student enrollment, include Sciences, Engineering, Education, Business and Technology, Humanities and Social Sciences, Agriculture, Home Economics, Pharmacy and Forestry. Eighty separate departments are included in the nine schools.

The number of students working for advanced degrees—masters and doctors degrees—has doubled in the past 10 years. Today, about 11 percent of the students at Oregon State are in the Graduate School. National reports of two years ago showed that OSU ranked 7th in the West and 41st in the U.S. in the number of doctor degrees awarded during each of the past five years.

Eighty major buildings are located on the 400-acre main Oregon State University campus. Approximately 4,000 acres adjoining the main campus are owned and used by the University for research and instruction, and 24,000 acres more are utilized by Branch Experiment Stations for research. The School of Forestry owns and administers 14,300 acres of forest land within seven miles of the campus for instructional and research purposes.

Value of the Oregon State University plant is estimated at approximately \$60,000,000—compared with about \$8,000,000 thirty years ago.

Oregon State University is nationally-known for many of its major specialized fields. OSU was one of the first colleges to establish work in Food Science; its department of Fish and Game Management and Forest Engineering are unique and highly regarded; all of the schools and departments are fully accredited.

Students from every county in Oregon, 47 states and 63 other countries are attending Oregon State this year.

OSU is a part of a world-wide system of seismograph stations reporting and studying earthquakes.

Oregon State University has become one of the foremost ocean research centers in America. Its oceanography teaching program is the fourth largest in the nation. OSU has its own "navy", too.

OSU has the only nuclear reactor in Oregon, a \$165,000 gift from the Atomic Energy Commission. It is used to train students in Physics, chemistry, chemical engineering, mechanical engineering, and other technical fields for careers in nuclear science.

OSU has the only cyclotron in the State of Oregon. It was built by OSU scientists. A gigantic electronic computer is now under construction by the Department of Mathematics and Electrical Engineering. It will be capable of solving the most complex research problems, (aided, of course, by the highly trained scientists in the two departments).

Oregon State is one of the only 34 institutions in the country that offers ROTC work in all branches of the military service—army, navy, air force and marine corps. ROTC training is voluntary.

Oregon State University is the West's top center for science-mathematics teacher institutes sponsored by the National Science Foundation. It was one of the first 16 U.S. universities selected to give the teacher training.

KNOW YOUR COACHES —

RALPH COLEMAN, BASEBALL—Native of Canby, Ore., where he attended high school. At OSU from 1914-1918, with service as a lieutenant in army during World War I spaced in between. Started coaching at OSU in 1923 and has been on job ever since, except for brief 6-year stint when press of other campus duties forced him to temporarily give up baseball. On P.E. staff since June of 1919 and director of summer session recreational program many years. Also was pro baseball pitcher in PCL. Now in his 35th season of coaching baseball at OSU, has all-time record of 527-281. Led Beavers to northern division crowns in 1940, 1951, 1952, 1958, 1962 and 1963. Tied for top spot in 1938 and 1943. Went all the way to NCAA regional crown in 1952.

SAM BELL, TRACK—Born at Columbus, Missouri, but attended high school at Giltner and Aurora in Nebraska, where he was four-sports star. In navy from 1945 through 1946 and attended Doane college in Crete, Neb., where he competed in football and track. First coaching job at Wymore, Neb., from 1950 through 1952. Was at Central High of Monmouth-Independence (Ore.) next, and from 1955 through 1958 at Cottage Grove high school where he developed Oregon's miler Dyrol Burleson. Took on OSU job in spring of 1959 and in 1960 OSU placed 4th at NCAA for its highest finish ever. Dual meet record is 32-15. Has coached 9 all-Americans, plus two in cross-country.

JACK GOODMAN, GOLF—Originally from Hillsboro, Ore., where he graduated from high school in 1940. Attended Pacific University in Forest Grove from 1940-1942, prior to military service in the army in the Chemical Warfare Service. Graduated from Pacific in 1948 and got master's degree in 1949 at Colorado State in Greeley. After serving as grade school principal, joined Visual Aids department at OSU in 1953 and has been on job ever since as Library manager and assistant to the director for business affairs. This is his second season as head golf coach for the Beavers.

DON MEGALE, TENNIS—Now in his first season as OSU tennis coach is Don Megale, who was one of the Beavers' brightest stars when in school here. Megale hails from Coos Bay, Oregon, and played both basketball and tennis as a prepper. At OSU, he was No. 1 man on Coach Harris' club for two years, graduating in 1952. He coached Klamath Falls to the state championship in both basketball and tennis, before returning to the OSU physical education department.
