This meet is sanctioned by the Niagara Association, Amateur Athletic Union, Albert M. Zahorsky, Chm., in accordance with I.A.A.F. rules.

International track competition with Oxford and Cambridge for the combined teams of Cornell-Princeton and Harvard-Yale was suggested in 1920 by the late John T. (Terry) McGovern '00 when he accompanied the Cornell cross country team to London for a meet with Oxford-Cambridge. The following year the Oxford-Cambridge trackmen met Cornell and Princeton at Travers Island in New York City. With the exception of the Olympic years, and until Pennsylvania replaced Princeton in 1953, Oxford-Cambridge would meet Cornell-Princeton and Harvard-Yale in the United States one year with Cornell-Princeton going to London the next year and Yale-Harvard going the following year. Next year Cornell and Pennsylvania will compete in London.

Oxford-Cambridge will meet Harvard-Yale at Harvard Tuesday.

First place only counts in the team scoring and the combined teams are limited to two entries in each individual event.

Selection of the Cornell-Pennsylvania competitors is on the basis of their annual dual meet. Each school then allows challenges among its own personnel, including freshmen.

As a Yale senior in 1964, at the Heptagonal indoor championships in Cornell's Barton Hall, Wendell Mottley put on two of the great performances in track history. On a flat board track, without benefit of spikes, he set the existing world record of 1:09.2 for the 600-yard run and later ran his mile relay leg in 46.7, the fastest relay quarter ever clocked indoors. . . . At the Olympic Games in Tokyo, Mottley, a native of Trinidad, was a close runnerup to Mike Larrabee of the U.S. in the 400-meter race.

Two other Cambridge students, Jim Axtell and Steve Cohen, have also competed at Cornell, Jim (Yale '63) winning the broad jump at the '62 Heps and Steve (Harvard '61) placing fourth in the '61 Heps shot put.

Allan Malcolm of Cambridge also coached the 1961 team that appeared here.

Tom Gage of Cornell has established himself as the outstanding all-around weightman in Ivy League history. . . . His 59-foot shot put, enabling him to win the event at the Penn Relays this year, is the best ever by an Ivy League competitor. He won this year's IC4A hammer throw with 197-1½ and he has thrown the discus 157-7.
