Two Mile

LOS ALTOS HILLS — Youthful Mike Ryan, showing no sign of the leg injury which sidelined him the first month of track and field competition, accomplished a man-sized feat with a 4:10.4 mile to sparkle in Saturday's Andrew Hill Invitational.

The Wilcox High senior and Homestead High freshman Manny Mahon, two promising distance standouts, were the stars of the fourth annual event witnessed by 1,500 spectators at Foothill College.

Mahon got the 22 event program off to a brisk start with an unappreciated 9:38.2 two-mile clocking that met with mixed emotions before the record-hungry crowd. The freshman ace did set an American prep yearling record for the eight-lapper, tumbling his listed 9:50.9.

Ryan, to whom the meet was dedicated, shared the outstanding runner award with Overfelt's Lee Evans. Five judges were torn between Ryan's feat and Evans' winning 880 relay anchor, 21.9 furlong and 48.1 quarter for three meet records to get our vote.

Ryan bolted to a nearly lead and sewed up victory in the final 300 yards with a powerful kick in the backstretch. His clocking bettered his Central Coast record 4:11.2 set in winning the 1964 State Interscholastic title and was the seventh best in prep annals.

The three-time Hill mile champion has been exceeded by only Jim Ryan, Wichita East (3:59.0); Tom Sullivan, Evanston, Ill. (4:03.5); Gerry Lindgren, Spokane Rogers (4:06.); Dennis Carr, LaHabra Lowell (4:08.9); Archie San Romani Jr., Wichita East (4:08.9) and Morgan Groth, Alhambra Martinez (4:10.0).

In smashing his meet record 4:17.2, Ryan pulled Los Altos Dale Bennett and Homestead's Rich Brackett to respective 4:18.4 and 4:18.9 life-bests.

Mahon and a stellar two-mile field refused to be awed by Wilcox' John Henry, who romped to a quick 25-yard lead and threatened to run his opposition into the ground for five laps.
