

# Lyman stars as Los Altos tips MV in track

Muscular Brad Lyman roared to an outstanding early season sprint time to pace Los Altos High School to a 93-43 Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track win Friday.

Lyman navigated the 220-yard distance in 21.8, a top mark for this time of the year. He added a 10.0 win in the 100.

Randy Beck came up with a pair of wins in the weight events for Los Altos, taking the shot put with a 53-8 effort and the discus in 166-3.

# Lyman hits 21.6 for fastest 220

Brad Lyman of Los Altos raced to the fastest 220 time in the Central Coast Section this season to highlight Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track action Thursday.

The SCVAL meets were scheduled for Friday but were moved up because the Hill invitational is being run at Foothill College Saturday.

Lyman was clocked in 21.6, beating his previous top mark of 21.8. The time gives him the second best 220 time in the state. The muscular Lyman also reeled off his "usual" 9.8 100 to become a double winner for the Knights.

Cupertino's Frank Hughes turned in the top 440 time in the CCS by flashing to a 49.4 time. Los Altos won the meet, 87-49.

In other meets Thursday, Fremont turned back Lynbrook, 80-53, and Mountain View took Buchser, 72-63.

Top field mark of the day came from Homestead's Ralph Show, who tossed the discus 170-10 to put him up among the best in the CCS.

The expected long jump-triple jump duel between Homestead's Phil Quinet and Sunnyvale's Charlie Steffes was a draw. Quinet captured the long jump with a 22-3 $\frac{3}{4}$  leap and Steffes was the triple jump winner at 44-8 $\frac{1}{2}$ . Both have done better.

Steve Bielenberg of Homestead captured both hurdle races with good times of 15.0 and 20.4. Dave Sanford ran the mile in 4:27.0 for the 'Tangs.

# Quinet tops Homestead's track victory

An outstanding double win by Homestead High School's Phil Quinet highlighted the Mustangs' 78-58 win over Los Altos in Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track competition Thursday.

Quinet won the long jump with a 23-3 leap, three inches off his season best, and then went 46-7 in the triple jump, his best effort of the year.

In other SCVAL meets Thursday, Manny Mahon ran a 4:20.3 mile but Lynbrook lost to Cupertino, 74-61; Sunnyvale whipped Fremont, 81-55, and Santa Clara edged Buchser, 69-67.
