Cal Poly track meet

More than 25 college, high school and junior high school girls competed in the seventh annual Cal Poly Invitational Girl's and Women's track meet at Cal Poly on Saturday.

San Diego State was first in the college division with 102.5 points. Ventura College was second with 102, and Cal Poly at Pomona was third with 82.

Poly runners placing in the college division included: Linda McArthur, second, 880-yard run; Nancy Thwing, first, 100-yard dash; Joyce Walker, first, javelin, and McArthur and Thwing, first, 440-yard relay.

San Luis Obispo High School runners placed sixth in the 440-relay, and fourth in the high jump.

In junior high school competition, Kim Korhrs and Debbie Willis of Frances Judkins Intermediate in Pismo

Beach each placed second in the 50-yard hurdles and the 50-yard dash.

Darlynn Larsen of Atascadero and Nancy Boschen of Judkins placed second and third in the 440-yard run. Debbie Willis, Judkins, and Delores Vargas of Glen Speck in Paso Robles were first and second in the 100-yard dash. Ramona Skidmore of Atascadero was second in the 220-yard dash. Atascadero was first in the 880-yard medley relay and second in the 440 relay.

Bonnie Johnson, Atascadero, was second in the shot put. Pam Jackson of San Luis Obispo and Sarah Arnold of Judkins were first and third in the long jump. Sally Gains of Atascadero was third in the softball throw.

Atascadero was first in the high jump and San Luis Obispo placed third.
