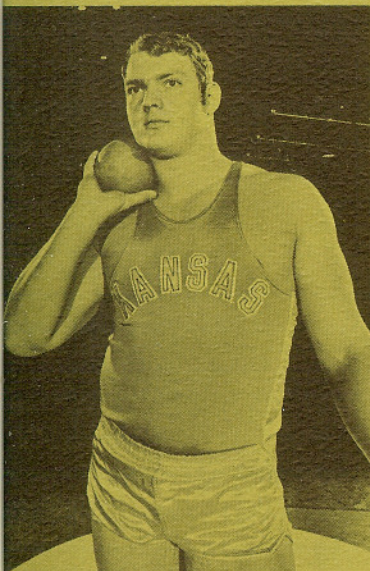

Closeness only counts in horseshoes and the last two CCC outdoor championships which have been decided by one point. Indiana took last year's title by edging Bowling Green, 52-51, and Ohio University stole the crown in 1969 on BG's Whittaker Track by nipping Western Michigan and Kansas by a 61 to 60½ to 60 count.

With shot put king Bob Winchell and 220-dazzler Mike Goodrich back to defend their titles, and sprinter Larry Highbaugh in the wings, Indiana has enough top performers to make a successful run at defending its title. Western Michigan, 1971 MAC champion, looms as a strong challenger along with Kansas if the Jayhawks enter a full team.

At least five NCAA champions are entered with the list including Sid Sink of Bowling Green who will be trying for his fourth victory in the 3000-meter steeplechase.

Special Events

In the memory of three men who have been instrumental in the founding and development of the Central Collegiate Conference, the CCC is proud to recognize their efforts with three special events named in their honor.

The Ralph H. Young 440-Yard Relay recognizes Ralph Young, former Michigan State athletic director and track coach and a founder of the CCC in 1926.

The Conrad M. Jennings One Mile Relay honors Con Jennings, athletic director (1926-1956) and track coach (1922-1949) at Marquette University who founded the CCC with Young and the great Knute Rockne.

The Stanley Lowe One Mile Run will be held for the first time this year in honor of Stan Lowe, former athletic director at Marquette University and executive secretary of the CCC whose dynamic leadership was a guiding force to the CCC until his untimely death in 1969.
