Baton Pass Foil's LACC's Title Hopes

MODESTO—Bakersfield College scored 39 points to win the team title in the State junior college track and field championships Saturday night at Modesto Junior College Stadium.

L.A. City College, one of the favorites, blew its chances when it dropped the baton on the second exchange in the 440 relay, an event the Cubs had been picked to win. LACC finished fifth with 30 points.

Charlie Rich of L.A. Southwest, who last week set a national jaysee record of 13.5 in the 120-yard high hurdles, was upset by Fresno's Jerry Wilson in 13.7, a meet record.

Rich, off to a bad start, trailed by three yards midway in the race. He closed strongly and was clocked in 13.9 but appeared to be closer.

Heulon Hewitt of Merced set a meet record of 25-6 3/4 in the long jump.

MODESTO — Harry Freeman of San Jose City College established a state meet record in the triple jump Saturday in the California Junior College track championships.

Freeman, who won the Northern California title last week with a leap of 50-10, spanned 51-1 3/4 Saturday to eclipse the old mark of 50-3 3/4 set by James Butts of East Los Angeles here last year.

Jim Petralia of DeAnza won the 440-yard intermediate hurdles in 53.0 in the only other winning effort by athletes from the Santa Clara Valley.

Bakersfield won the team title with 39 points with Merritt College second at 37. Merritt missed a possible third straight team championship when Royce Ford, picked for a fourth place in the 100, was disqualified for two false starts.
