Disqualification Costs JC Title

MODESTO — Two false starts in the 100-yard dash by Royce Ford probably cost Xerritt College of Oakland an unprecedented third consecutive Szate Jufior College track and field championship yesterday.

Had the T-Bird sprinter not been disqualified, it is doubtful if Bakersfield would have won its first State title. Ford, who had run 9.6 this year, would only have had to equal that time on the fast Modest JC track for Merritt to win.

As things turned out, Bakersfield finished with 39 points to 37 for Merritt. Third was Fresno CC, 35 points, followed by Mt. San Antonio, 34 points.

Merritt started fast by winning the 440 relay, but Bakersfield was second in that event and then scored heavily in the field events. Merritt closed with a victory in the mile relay, pulling the T-Birds into second place.

Three meet records were set, including a 13.7 high hurdle clocking by Fresno's Jerry Wilsn, who beat National record holder Charles Rich of LA Southwest.
