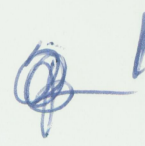

Hedline: Doris Brown Sets American Mile Record

Subhed: Nine meet records fall

Doris Brown, a petite Seattle school teacher who runs for the Falcon Track Club outlegged three pursuers to win the women's mile in 4:39.6 before 6,500 fans at Portland's Rose Festival Track & Field meet.

This is almost two seconds under the American women's mile record she set less than a week ago. A back problem and scar tissue from hamstring pulls makes training a chore for Miss Brown - and was the reason ^{that} why the promised duel with Francie Kraker Johnson of Boston, in the 880, failed to materialize. Miss Johnson won in 2:08.4. The two speedsters are paired again at the Urbana, Ill. meet next week.

The two longest throwers in American history gave stature to a fine Festival javelin field, but defending champion Larry ^{Stuart} Stewart of the So. Cal. Striders connected on his final toss and won at 267'2". A high school spearman from Pleasant Hill, however, stole the headlines. Russ Francis, who had set a national high school javelin mark at 254'11" earlier this spring, reset it at the Portland meet on his first throw at 259'9", and led the event until Stewart's final toss.

Gerry Lindgren, who has not run - let alone been invited to an important meet this season - won the 3-mile event in 13;16.1, beating former Oregon U. runner, Ken Moore. "This is the first big meet I've been invited to this year," said the Cougar Track Club runner. "I guess they think I'm over the hill. Maybe I was lucky to pick up this one."

Another Cougar, Art Sandison, powered past the 880 field to win in 1:48.69. The old favorites came through again in most of the field events. Randy Matson won the shot at 65'8 $\frac{1}{4}$ "; Tim Vollmer won the discus with a throw of 193'5" and Tom Gage took the hammer first place with 216'8".

Olympic gold medalist Lee Evans outgunned Edesel Garrison in the 440 and won at 46.03. USC's Willie Deckard won the 100 yard dash against a speedy field at 9.5 and Don Quarrie of the Striders took the 220 at 20.4. Debbie Brill, Vancouver BC International club, set a meet mark with 5'9 $\frac{1}{4}$ " in the women's high jump. Joyce Sandowich, also of the Vancouver club, recorded an upset in winning the women's 440 at 55:04.
