Outsiders Grab Most Honors At Cal State

FULLERTON — With most of its top performers saving their efforts for Sunday's Southern Pacific AAU meet at UC Irvine, Cal State Fullerton played a polite host and let visitors run away with most of the honors at the CSF Invitational track meet Saturday.

The Titans got first place performances from Ken Grant in the long jump with a leap of 22-3 $\frac{3}{4}$, Jerry Jones in the triple jump with a distance of 45-8 $\frac{3}{4}$ and Curt Thompson with a 1:54.9 in the 880.

No team scoring was kept between the athletes from various colleges, junior colleges and Athletes in Action.

Cal Poly Pomona's Ray Daglow was the lone double winners in the meet, run in the cool morning breeze, taking the 440 in 48.9 and the 220 in 21.8.

The toughest competition came in the pole vault where three men cleared 15 feet, topped by Cal Poly San Luis Obispo's Mike Deitchman at 15-10.

In the hurdles, Ward Kinsman, former Sunny Hills star now a freshman at SLO, placed second behind Valley State's Richard Deza who won in 14.6.
