# Evans Runs Season's Best in 440 Hurdles

SAN DIEGO — (AP) — Lee Evans, world record holder in the 400 meter run, turned in the season's fastest time in the 440 hurdles here yesterday to highlight the 12th annual San Diego Relays at Balboa Stadium.

Evans' effort of 50.2 seconds

moved him past Rice University standout Mike Bolding, who ran 50.5 last weekend at the Texas Relays.

A San Jose State College teacher and assistant coach, Evans competed unattached in the meet, which was viewed by 4100

fans. He led a strong field from start to finish in recording his all-time best for the event.

Wesley Williams, former San Diego State intermediate specialist competing for the San Diego Track Club, came on strong over the final 50 yards to take second in 50.5.

Ronnie Ray Smith, a 1968 Olympian and holder of the world record for the 100-meter dash, got his season under way with a fine victory in the 100-yard dash. Smith ran 9.3 in the prelims of the event and then did 9.4 to win the finals.

The U.S. Army's 440 relay team zipped to a 40.0 clocking, one of the fastest in the world this year. The team was composed of Jimmy White, Jerry Bright, Fred Newhouse and Ben Vaughn. San Diego State's Arnie Robinson went 25-5 in the long jump.

Two separate Pacific Coast Club relay teams captured events at one and two miles.

The mile quartet of Bob Frey, Jay Elbel, Terry Musika and Len Van Hofwegen raced to a 3:07.7 time, best in the world this year, and the two-mile crew of John Lawson, John Mason, George Scott and Chuck LaBenz went 7:29.4.
