Reggie bobinson put on a great finish in the 100 and ran a superb les on the 440 relay in his first start after being incligible earlier this year. The 220 and 440 both produced theilling finished, and with the same cast-John Smith held off Darwin Bond's closing rush in the quarter for a half-yard win, then had to do it again in the furlong, bond was certainly ingrassing and will be under him was certainly impressive and will bear watching as the season progresses. AC2a's margin in the 440 relay appeared larger than the three-tenth margin would indicate - It looked to be five or fix yards. My watch and the one next to me both chught The Guine in 39,8 with Gennessee in the official 40.4, also on both watches. The bourportal jumps again were spectacelar-mealister getting 10th on the all-time Uf list while upping his school record to 26-62 (and on the first jump, or usual).
