# Cal Track Team an Easy Victory, 103-42

Despite a series of irksome minor injuries, California opened its varsity track season yesterday at Edwards Stadium with what coach Dave Maggard admitted was "an easier victory than we had expected." The

Bears defeated Sacramento State, 103-42.

There were really few surprises in the meet except the victory of the Bears' 440 relay team in 41.1 (they had run only 46.6 in practice) and the sweep in which they got the bulk of their points.

A year ago, the Bears

pole vault or a 1-2 in the two-mile would have been as unheard of as an Army recruiting table in Sproul Plaza.

But yet that's what happened. Admittedly the marks weren't exceptional but they represented a dramatic improvement and they were good enough to bring points.

## JC Transfers

Newcomers were responsible for most of the improvement. JC transfers Mike Weidig and Ed Weidig Otter each won 15-0 in the pole vault. Weidig the winner in the shot put misses. Another JC transfer, Mike Bartel, was third at 14-6.

In the two mile, it was a pair of freshmen: German-born Wolfgang Schmuliewicz and Canadian Brian Maxwell. Schmuliewicz was first in 9:06.8 and Maxwell was next in a lifetime best of 9:09.

Ironically it was also this race that produced one of Cal's few disappointments as veteran Eguenio Amaya faded badly and finished only fourth in 9:16.02.

## Shot Sweep

A hand injury prevented Rolin Luka from winning the shot put as expected. But teammate Jim Penrose, making his first varsity appearance in the event, put 54-9½ to lead the Cal sweep. He later also led a sweep of the discus, with a meet record throw of 177-9.

The injured list included triple jumper Craig Conway (knee and ankle), high jumper Mal MacFarlane (knee) and javelin thrower Bruce Kennedy (forearm), all of whom won in the individual
