Jumping around joyously and embracing everyone from
teammates to the janitor, a happy Greg Cortina finally went
over 60 feet ^{with} ~~the~~ the 16 pound shot.

"I've been trying for five years," the Notre Dame weight-
man told an astonished janitor. "I finally did it, wow, 60'
10"."

Cortina, who hit 68' 9" with the 12 pound and 58' 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ "
with the 16 lb. in high school, was a hit with the crowd
because of his unique "psyching up" anti^{cs}~~cs~~. He stomps
around the 60 foot marker like an enraged beast, then he
tries to intimidate it (the "60 foot barrier") by yelling,
and defecating at it. Finally he takes out his frustration
with the 16 pound ball and he'll have to find a new barrier,

Distance runners, Craig Macdonald, ^{AND} Dave Wottle of
Bowling Green and Gary Harris of Western Michigan did
some shattering of their own. ~~the~~ Harris was the meets' only
double winner (mile and three mile) and Wottle and MacDonald
anchored ^(36's) ~~the~~ two and distance medley relays to victory.

Harris was pushed to a 13:43 three mile Friday
night by Gordon Minty of second place team, Eastern
Michigan (89 pts). On Saturday the push came from MacDonald,
as the two waged a last lap duel with Harris prevailing
4:04.9 to 4:05.1.

Wottle, who came off a 1500 meter victory in New York
the night before, contributed a 1:50.9 to Bowling Green's
7:39.5 two-mile relay victory. Plus A

-more-

second place finish in the two mile behind teammate Sid Sink, who took second in ~~New York~~ the 3,000 meters at New York, to help Bowling Green into third in the team scoring with 74 points.

Stan Vinson of ^(mile relay victory) Easter Michigan, added a 47.5 anchor leg to his winning 1:10.5 600 to close out the meet. He overtook first and third place quarter ~~men~~ men, Steve Jordan of Kentucky State and Ed Sutton of Southern Illinois with an astonishing burst on the final straight.
