Most notable mark was a 51-7½ triple jump by Southern Cal's Henry Jackson on Friday, and he followed that with a 23-11½ long jump win and a 48.2 leg on the winning mile relay squad. The Trojan four-lappers clocked a creditable 3:12.3 without aces Edesel Garrison and Tony Krzyzosiak.

Long Beach State took advantage of SC's 880 récord attempt and clocked 40.8 to top the Trojan second team's 41.6 in the 440 relay. Despite Jackson's three wins, Athlete of the Meet honors went to Arizona Mesa JC's Jim Euell for his 4:08.5 anchor in a 9:59.8 distance medley and 1:51.0 sprint medley wrap-up. Most spectacular relay leg was turned in by Northern Arizonéa's Steve Cross with 1:49.0 in the two mile won in 7:34.
