~~ANN ARBOR, MICHIGAN--2-25-72--The hurdles, shot put, two mile run, and mile relay made the~~

ANN ARBOR, MICHIGAN--2-25-72--In what was supposed to be a low-key affair, the Michigan Open proved to be a meet filled with fine ~~fixfixfix~~ performances and a few surprises.

In the hurdles, U-M/Jamaican Pan-Am finalist Godfrey Murray ran his third collegiate tying 8.1 in the 70 yard high hurdles this season. "My start usually isn't too good, but today it was exceptional," said Murray, a junior, "I think that anywhere else, that race would have been a 7.9 or 8.0 but these Michigan finish judges tend to catch your backside instead of your lean."

Murray has timed three 8.1's, two 8.2's, and an 8.3 this season over the 70's, plus a fourth place 7.1 over 55 meters at the Olympic Invitational. ^{He's} Built alot like Hayes ^{so he} Jones, ~~Murray~~ and his hurdles coach Ken Burnley are ~~xxx~~ trying to ^{turn} ~~xxx~~ the Hayes '64 ~~formula~~ formula into a '72 Olympic winner. "Godfrey always had the speed and strength to be good hurdler," ~~said~~ Burnley, "Now we're trying to get the ~~strength~~ technique down."

Another U-M athlete that impressed was sophomore Steve Adams who thre^w the shot 59'0", a PR by 1/2".

Distancewise, Eastern Michigan's NCAA-CD 3 and 6 mile champ Gordon Minty ran a PR 8:43.7 two-mile to ^{outsprint} ~~beat~~ the 8:48.4 of England/AATC's Paul Lightfoot. Michigan's Phil Pyatt was a fast third with a PR 8:50.4.

"Paul set a beautiful pace," said Minty, "Sixty-six, that's what I wanted. And I was satisfied with my kick

(60.9 last quarter) because ~~I~~ contrary to popular belief, I don't think I've got much of a kick, and this was alright."

The mile relay action saw Eastern Michigan clock a PR 3:13.0 to Michigan's surprising PR 3:13.7. Eastern had run 3:13.5 two weeks before ~~at~~ ^{on Tartan at} the Michigan State Relays only to be disqualified on a questionable line charge while Michigan's ~~had~~ outdoor 3:08.5 unit had yet to dip below 3:16 indoors.

Eastern's team was tired and not prepared for the fired-up Michigan squad. freshman Stan Vinson EMU anchorman had earlier run a 48.7 quarter with lead-off man Ian Hall of Jamaica second in 49.0. Hall also won the 300 in 31.1 while EMU third leg Gary Collins ran a PR 1:10.8 600.

Michigan ran their anchorman ~~first~~ Kim Rowe on lead-off, as both Rowe and Hall ran identical 48.3's. U-M's Eric Chapman, a half-miler who had run 1:11.2 earlier, opened up a lead on Eastern's Willie Sims ~~xx~~ by a 48.9 to 49.4 margin. Collins' 48.3 closed on Reggie Bradford's 48.5. Michigan's anchorman Gary Syphax got only a precarious two-tenth lead on Vinson, who has been incredibly consistent with top legs of 47.5, 47.6, and 47.7.

With 110 yards ~~xx~~ remaining, Vinson blew past Syphax to record a seven-tenth margin. Vinson ~~was~~ was clocked by several judges in 47.0 while Syphax ran a still ^{respectable} ~~credible~~ 47.9.

"Ah man, it's hard to believe," said Vinson, who has also run a 1:10.0 ~~xxxx~~ inter-squad 600 and 1:10.5 race 600 this season, "Everything was beautiful." EMU Coach Bob Parks commented, "To be honest, I thought we'd never do it again. I thought the conditions at Michigan State were perfect,

but the guys showed ^{me} that they can run ^{well} anywhere."

A National Collegiate Record Equating performance in the high hurdles and hot finishes in two of the oval events highlighted the Michigan Open Meet.

Godfrey Murray tied the national collegiate best in the 70 H_H for the second time this season with an 8.1. Leading from start to finish, the Jamaican junior showed the skeptics that his earlier 8.1 performance two weeks ago was no fluke. Former N.A.A.A. 490 hurdles champ Corey Bouyer ran second in 8.4, in what may have been his first race since the 1970 N.A.A.A. outdoor championships.

A quick pace was set by Paul Lightfoot in the two mile, but the British graduate student was easily outkicked by countryman Gordon Minty in 8:43.7. The fast and even pace saw the top three school athletes all break varsity records. Jon Torres of Genesee Community College may have set an indoor junior college best with his 8:56.3. He was the top American finisher in the race as foreigners copped the first three places.

The mile relay was a scorcher. Eastern Michigan and Michigan ran up and took all the way. Freshman sensation Stan Linson's 47.0 anchor finished off a 3:13.0 first place for Eastern Michigan.

This time missed the "D" track record best by only one tenth of a second. The team had run 3:13.5 two weeks ago but was disqualified for cutting in on the turns. The two schools rank second and third nationally among colleges. The surprising Ann Arbor

Track Club (running without Kent Beernard) was never in the race but still managed a 3:13.9.
