Meanwhile---back at the track. The wind was a steady 10-15 MPH between 7 and 8 PM during the 100 heats, according to the weather bureau and in the first heat Miller got the jump on the starter, which accounts for--

his 9.1 and Rufus Nesbitt's 9.2, Nesbitt had an earlier 9.6. Willie McGee got a terrific start and really blew down the track, but I didn't believe my watch's 9.0 until the official time was ~~xxxxxxxxxx~~ announced. Sincere's 9.3 looked creditable when looking at his 9.5 at ~~xxxxxxxxxxxx~~ Prairie View earlier in the year., ~~mizxxxx~~ Even after the first two heats I still wasn't ready for Robert Taylor's 9.0 and Eddie Capitol's 9.1

The finals on Saturday were more believable and although the weather bureau said that there was very little wind during the time of the 100 final, (the airport is less than two miles from the stadium) in fact they said the average wind reading for that period was 3.0 knots. However, since there was no windmeter on the track itself I will call all sprint and hurdle races and horizontal jumps WINDY.
