## Women thinclads upend San Fernando Valley St., Pomona

The Aztec women's track team, hosting the first intercollegiate event of its kind in San Diego State history, ran, jumped, and tossed their way to victory Saturday over San Fernando Valley State and Pomona College.

The Aztecs finished a top the triangle with 104 points while San Fernando netted 61 and Pomona 14. State dominated, tallying nine firsts and seconds out of the thirteen events. It was the initial outing of the season for all three teams.

Coach Cindy Hollyfield was generous in her praise of State's performers. "It was a total team effort, I'm very pleased with both the win and the way the girls prepared themselves." Although

declining to single anyone out, the coach was impressed with Viki Hallman's showing. Viki collected two blue ribbons, in the javelin with a tremendous heave of 145'9½" and the 100 yard dash with a time of 11.8 seconds. She capped the day by placing second to San Fernando's Terry Williams (35'5¼") in the shot put with a pitch of 32'2¾".

The spikettes next test will be the upcoming UCLA Invitational on Friday. 11 schools are attending, including highly touted Ventura JC; gun time is set for 1:00 p.m. on the Bruin oval.

"We're hoping to beef up our schedule," said coach Hollyfield. "And the UCLA meet will provide

us with some contacts. It's been difficult to find competition due to the strength of the local AAU teams."

Despite meager funding and lack of league organization, the team operates on around \$300 and interest is on the upswing. "Last year, which was our first," continued Hollyfield, "we had 9 girls participating; we've doubled that this year and enthusiasm has also greatened. We've got quite a win string going now and I hope the momentum carries over to Friday."

The string dates back to '71 when the Aztecs finished first out of 14 at San Luis Obispo and second in the six-way Cal Poly Pomona meet.
