## THE AZTEC COACHES

### DICK WELLS

#### Head Track and Field Coach



Guiding the Aztecs into the 1972 season will be Dick Wells who will be beginning his sixth season as head coach. Wells took over the reins as head coach from long-time veteran Choc Sportsman in 1967 after having served as Sportsman's assistant since 1961. In five seasons he owns a record of 30-19.

Wells began his coaching career at Occidental College, where he received his B.A. degree in 1953, as an assistant to Payton Jordan. After one year at Oxy, Wells came to San Diego State and, apart from helping out Sportsman, was also the Aztec freshman-JV football coach.

Surprisingly, Wells concentrated on football when he was a student at Occidental, playing four seasons and being named to the all-conference team once. He also competed in track for one season and threw the discus, but, as Dick puts it, "I was not very good." Wells was also a footballer in high school, starring for North Hollywood High School where he was all-league and all-city.

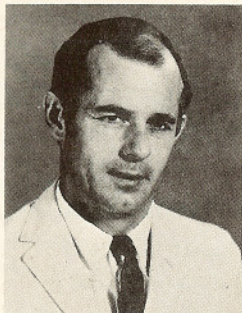
A Navy veteran from 1953-60, Dick is married to the former Barbara Kyne and has three children: Rick 16, Ken, 15, and Laura, 12.

Academically, besides his B.A., Wells holds a M.A. from San Diego State and is currently working on his Ph.D. through the United States International University.

### TONY SUCEC

#### Assistant Track and Field Coach

Assisting head coach Dick Wells this season will be Tony Sucec who also doubles as the Aztec cross country coach. This actually is Tony's second tour of duty as an assistant track and field coach on the Mesa as he also worked under Choc Sportsman, along with Wells, from 1963-65. Tony has been in his present position since the 1967 season. Prior to returning to SDS he was the assistant frosh cross country and track and field coach at UC Berkeley from 1965-67.



Although born in Oakland, Sucec has spent most of his days here in the San Diego area. He attended St. Augustine High School, San Diego City College and finished up at State where he received both his A.B. and M.A. degrees. Tony also holds a Ph.D. degree from UC Berkeley.

A fine athlete himself, Sucec was the California Collegiate Athletic Association cross country champion in 1958 and then was runner-up in the CCAA mile during the 1959 track season. Additionally, he was a member of the All-Army team in 1960.

Tony is married (Marian) and has two children.

## AZTEC AIDES

Helping out with the coaching duties this spring will be a pair of graduate assistants, Jim Kiefer and George Wightman.

Kiefer was an aide last year also and worked primarily with the long and triple jumpers. Jim, 25, competed collegiately at the University of California in Berkeley and once took fifth in the Pac-8 triple jump. He attended Pasadena City College where he jumped his way to school records in both the triple and long jumps.

A native of Pasadena, he is married (Linda) and has a son, Jimmy, who is almost two years old.

New for this season only is George Wightman who will coach the hurdlers. Currently on a sabbatical leave from Saratoga High School in Northern California, he is working on his Master's Degree. At Saratoga he is the track and cross country coach.

He graduated from San Francisco State College in 1963 and went straight to Saratoga High. George also attended San Jose State and Santa Barbara City College and played football at both schools.

Wightman prepped at Carmel High School and won 14 letters in four sports. The highlight of his prep career was in track as he was undefeated in the mile in three years of competition.

George is married (Marlen) and has two children; Heather (8) and Mark (5).

## EVENT BREAKDOWN

**SPRINTS:** A healthy **Herbie Brown** (9.4) could be the key to any success the Aztecs may hope for. Hampered by leg troubles last year, it looks like he's in shape for a fine senior season. Junior **Dennis Williams** (9.7, 21.7) appears to be the best double man while support can be expected from **John Phillips** (9.7) and **Tim Vincent** (21.5). **Vincent** (48.7) will also help out in the 440 as will **Gerry Muszynski** (48.5).

**DISTANCE:** The Aztecs have a solid group of distance men. In the 880 it looks like junior **Jay Larkin** (1:52.6) while **Otis Martin** (4:07.4, 9:03.3, 13:57.0) is easily the class in the longer runs. Help should also come from **Mike Weaver** (4:15.0, 9:12.0) and **Dennis Garcia** (4:15.1).

**HURDLES:** Two evenly-matched newcomers head the way in the 120-HH in freshman **Gary Green** (14.4) and junior **Doug Smith** (14.4). Tops in the 440-IH looks like senior **Roy Gayhart** (54.6). The steeplechase corps features three strong runners in **Mike Cour** (9:22.0), **Scott Claypoole** (9:44.4) and **Jim Rendina** (9:47.0).

**JUMPS:** Graduation and eligibility problems stripped away the "name" performers but State still has some capable men. Veterans **Grady Rogers** (24-3 $\frac{1}{4}$ , 46-10) and **John Phillips** (24-1) will team with newcomers **Kent Thompson** (47-4) and **Doug Smith** (50.4) in the long and triple jumps. In the high jump **Dan Kinney** (6-5) stands out as does pole vaulter **Bob Daniels** (15-6).

**WEIGHTS:** Junior new man **Pat Foley** (164-7, 50-6) looks impressive as does another junior **Ray Chappell** (155-0, 48.0). In the javelin the honors go to vets **Tony Griswold** (218-6) and **Don Bajema** (200-1) who missed the 1971 campaign. **Griswold** could also be of aid in the shot, 49.8.
