

# Ryun vs. Arese Tops Times Games

Jim Ryun, picking his spots this year, can't be accused of selecting the soft ones.

For openers, he took on the Olympic champion, Kip Keino. Tonight he faces the European champion, Francesco Arese of Italy. They don't come much tougher.

An expected crowd of 16,000 will watch Ryun and Arese meet for the first time in the mile in the 13th annual Times Indoor Games at the Forum.

A total of 19 world record holders, representing 13 nations, will compete in the meet starting at 7:30 p.m. Tickets are still available and will go on sale at 9 a.m. today at the Forum.

In the two-mile, world record holders Emiel Puttemans of Belgium and Kerry O'Brien of Australia will be

challenged by precocious Steve Prefontaine, 21-year-old University of Oregon junior who hasn't lost a distance race since 1970.

Al Feuerbach, indoor record holder in the shot put at 69-43/4, will try to make it five straight wins over Randy Matson, 1968 Olympic champion and outdoor record holder at 71-51/2.

Matson is the only man who has thrown the shot over

70 feet. Feuerbach aims to become the second tonight. In the 600-yard run, world record holder Martin McGrady and Olympic champion Lee Evans will renew the hottest rivalry on the boards. Evans holds two wins over McGrady this winter but still trails the series, 9-3.
