NOTES ON THIRD ANNUAL WAC CONFERENCE INDOOR TRACK & FIELD MEET (FROM KEN MORRISON)

Fred DeBernardi of Texas El Paso not only equalled the NCAA indoor record in the shot put of 67-10, but had three other puts over 67 feet. However, he fouled on two of them.

The WAC indoor record in the 60-yard dash (set by Mike Fray of UTEP<sup>in 1970</sup> and tied by Harrington Jackson of UTEP in 1971) was equalled seven times in this meet, six times in the trials Friday night and once in the finals Saturday night.

Lorenzo Allen of Arizona tied the meet record of 7-0 in the high jump, but did not attempt to break the record.

UCLA track coach Jim Bush was guest lecturer at a track coaching clinic held in conjunction with the meet and was honorary head official.

Duane Esper of Pasadena, California, was the announcer on the public address system and did an excellent job.
