

SUBJECT: BADGER TRACKMEN WIN PAIR OF DUAL MEETS

MADISON, WIS -- SENIOR GREG JOHNSON AND JUNIOR CHUCK BAKER WERE DOUBLE WINNERS AS WISCONSIN'S INDOOR TRACK TEAM HANDED NORTHERN ILLINOIS AND CHICAGO TRACK CLUB DEFEATS HERE SATURDAY TO EXTEND THEIR UNBEATEN STRING TO 17 CONSECUTIVE DUAL MEETS IN A ROW SINCE LAST LOSING IN 1966.

THE BADGERS DEFEATED NORTHERN ILLINOIS 109-37 AND CHICAGO TRACK CLUB 92-48.

BAKER GOT THE BADGERS OFF TO A PERFECT START BY WINNING THE MILE RUN IN A CLOSE RACE WITH TEAMMATE MARK LARSON WITH BOTH TIMED IN 4:10.2 AND THE ELKHART, INDIANA NATIVE CAME BACK TO WIN THE 880 IN 1:55.1 LATER IN THE DAY.

JOHNSON WON THE 70 YARD HIGH HURDLES IN 8.5 SECONDS AND TOOK LONG JUMP HONORS WITH A LEAP OF 22 FEET 10 INCHES WHILE PLACING SECOND IN THE 70 YARD LOW HURDLES AT 8.2 SECONDS AS TEAMMATE GARY WILLIAMS, BERLIN FRESHMAN WON THE EVENT IN 8.1 SECONDS.

A PAIR OF CAMP RANDALL MEMORIAL BUILDING RECORDS WERE SHATTERED BY CHICAGO TRACK CLUB PERFORMERS AS BRIAN OLDFIELD TOSSED THE SHOT 63 FEET 9 INCHES AND JOHN CRAFT, THE TOP-RATED UNITED STATES TRIPLE JUMPER TURNED IN AN EFFORT OF 52 FEET 8 INCHES IN THE EVENT.

MIKE GOODRICH, FORMER INDIANA UNIVERSITY SPRING ACE ALSO WAS A DOUBLE WINNER AS HE WON THE 60 YARD DASH IN 6.3 SECONDS AND WON THE 300 YARD DASH IN THE EXCELLENT TIME OF 30.6 SECS.

WISCONSIN'S PAT MATZDORF, WORLD RECORD-HOLDER IN THE HIGH JUMP, COMPETED FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE INJURING A KNEE IN SAN FRANCISCO ^{TWO} WEEKS AGO AND WON THE EVENT AT 6 FEET 10 INCHES. HE LEAVES FOR PARIS, FRANCE MONDAY MORNING WHERE HE'LL RECEIVE AN AWARD AS THE WORLD'S SPORTSMAN OF THE YEAR FOR 1971.
